

The FFNC propose to create and develop a Community Garden Project. The aim is: to awaken the interest of the unemployed youth, young adults and interested mature adults in our environment.

The FFNC Garden Project will be in two parts.

Part 1

The main part will be to involve unemployed young adults in activities which will help them to identify their natural abilities and to provide training for further development.

Experienced mature adults will have the opportunity to practice their hobby and provide guidance, support, supervision and training for the inexperienced members of the project.

Part 2

This will be known as the Forest School Garden Project (FSGP) and will involve the 12–16 age group and will be developed for it's science and educational values. It will give the youngsters the opportunity to practice soil—testing, planting and growing what is best suited for the type of soil, to make compost, practice potting, create their own nature conversation project and serve as an after school project.

A Management and Supervisory Committee will be put in place to ensure that at all times responsible supervision is at hand.

What have Motown records and Credit Unions got in common? Very little you might think. But did you realise that the first Motown hit owed its success to the fact that money to meet the initial recording costs was borrowed from the local Credit Union in America? It certainly proved to be a worthwhile investment!

Our own local Credit Union has not yet reached that level of fame but it is certainly meeting the needs of a growing number of local people. Membership is now over 130, plus a small number of junior savers, and to date we have been able to approve over 80 low-cost loans. These have been used for car repairs, crisis bills, holidays, household goods etc.... all necessary expenses in today's society. Savers too have benefited, in that we were able to declare a 2% dividend on deposits made over the past year. Not much you may think, but in fact very competitive with similar schemes. But in the last analysis we are mainly concerned with using our monies to benefit local residents.

Forest Fields Playcentre.

Forest Fields playcentre has been running since 1986 at the site on Russell Road.

Term time open hours are:

Winter weekdays 3.15 - 6.30pm Summer weekdays 3.15 - 7.00pm

Saturdays 10.00 - 12.30 and 1.30 - 4.00pm

On Friday nights a girls only night is run. Children who don't wish to attend this can use the after school club at Forest Fields Community Centre.

During school holidays

we run daytime playschemes during these hours; 10.00 - 12.30 and 1.30 -4.00pm

People.

The playcentre has three full time workers, a number of volunteers who work face to face with children, and a voluntary management committee made up of local people and representatives.

The centre is open to any children living in the Forest Fields, Hyson Green, or New Basford areas from five to thirteen years old. The centre runs various activities throughout the open hours as well as simply providing space and facilities for kids to enjoy themselves. Adults may also come on during open hours and bring under fives with them.

Activities.

YOUR POLICE - The Way Forward

I welcome the opportunity to contribute to your magazine and to share with readers some of my thoughts on how I intend to police the area in the year ahead.

If I can start by looking back over 1993: we had a very busy year – more and more people required our help. In fact, well over 100,000 enquiries were received during the year. However with no growth in the number of operational officers, it has become necessary to grade the calls we respond to according to their severity.

Obviously, true emergencies are responded to immediately whilst others are dealt with at a late stage. Please be patient if your call for assistance is not an emergency – we will respond in due time and deal with your problem for you.

I think it is only right that, through your magazine, I publicly thank all the police officers who work at Radford Road Division. They have and still do work incredibly hard on your behalf. This has resulted in an increase in the detection rate of over 13% from 1992 to 1993. Moveover, the detections for Burglary offences is nearly 50% and for violent crime it is 86%. These results do not just happen and credit should be given to all my officers.

For the year ahead, I intend that the initiative on burglary and violent crime will continue. Furthermore, I intend to try and increase the number of uniform foot patrols in the area. I know many members of the community – especially the elderly

- take great comfort from seeing a police officer walking along the street. I also wish to improve the response times when we have to attend to incidents by car.

Hopefully, the creation of a new Crime Desk will free-up operational time by reducing the amount of paperwork all officers have to complete. This scheme is very much in its infancy but I am very enthusiastic about its progress.

Coupled with everything we do is the way we do it. I look to the future to increase our quality of service to all our customers, whether victims, witnesses or whoever treating everyone with courtesy and respect whether being dealt with over the telephone or face to face. Previous public surveys have shown that the majority of the public are delighted with the way they are dealt with but, as in all fields and in every organisation, there is always room for improvement.
