

Islington looks set to have the first out-gay mayor in Britain now that Cllr. Bob Crossman has been elected Deputy Mayor of the Borough. He was the popular choice of three candidates for the job and when elected to the Council five years' ago was the first open and positively gay Labour councillor to win election in this country. However, that did not stop the "Sun" from screeching in banner headlines usually reserved for a war alert or announcing its bingo winners - "Enter the Gay Mayor - Mayoress is to be his Fella". Cllr. Crossman is Chairperson of the Islington Council Lesbian and Gay Sub Committee and is also a member of the Inner London Education Authority. And Cllr. Crossman had a message for the Editor of the "Sun" and his staff - he would do a benefit for them to help them buy crayons so they could colour in the pictures of their paper!


