parenting course about to begin but several lesbians can't afford to come on the course, hence the idea of the fundraiser".

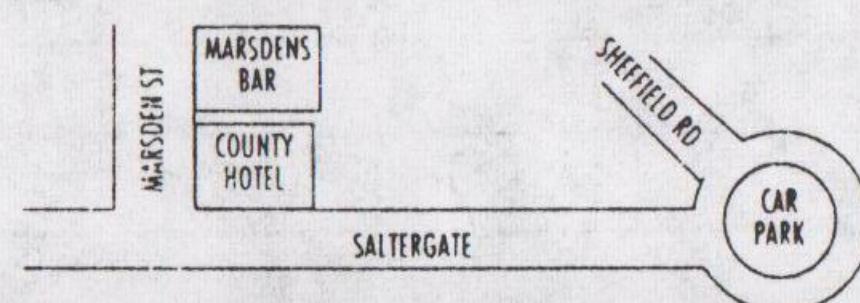

## NOTTINGHAM POLICE BACK DOWN

Cotting charges against a number of gay men have been dropped as a result of 'evidential difficulties', according to police spokesmen.

Since Outright reported the 'Police Vendetta on Gays' last October, several men have contacted us and disturbing facts have emerged.

The police have been using agents provocateurs, and accomplices hiding in attendants' rooms, to lure their victims, who have then been 'persuaded' to accompany police officers to the Central Police Station. There they have under-

gone interrogation, and intimidated by the experience, have made statements, but have been released without charge - only to find weeks later a letter dropping through their doors from the Crown Prosecution Service requiring them to appear before the Court on charges of Gross Indecency.

The OUTRAGE group contacted the MP for Sherwood, Paddy Tipping, who wrote to the Chief Constable, Dan Crompton asking for a report on the arrests. The Chief Constable confirmed that sixty four men had been arrested and

five police officers had been involved in the surveillance operation, including a Sergeant, in the period from the 7th September to 1st November.

Outright can now confirm that the original surveillance was mounted following complaints from lavatory attendants to the City Council who then met with the Police over the matter. However, the Police claim that complaints had been received from 'members of the public'. OUTRAGE and Outright maintain that neither lavatory attendants nor police

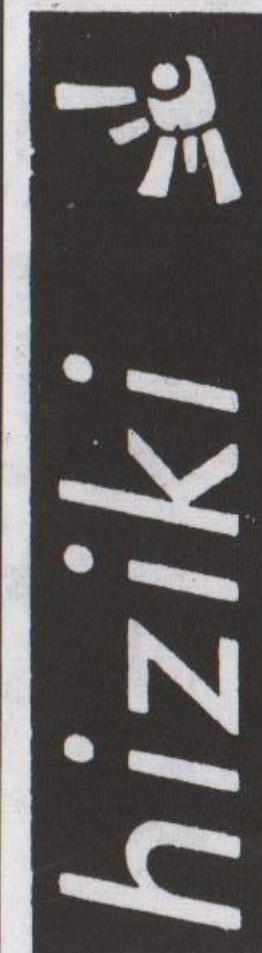

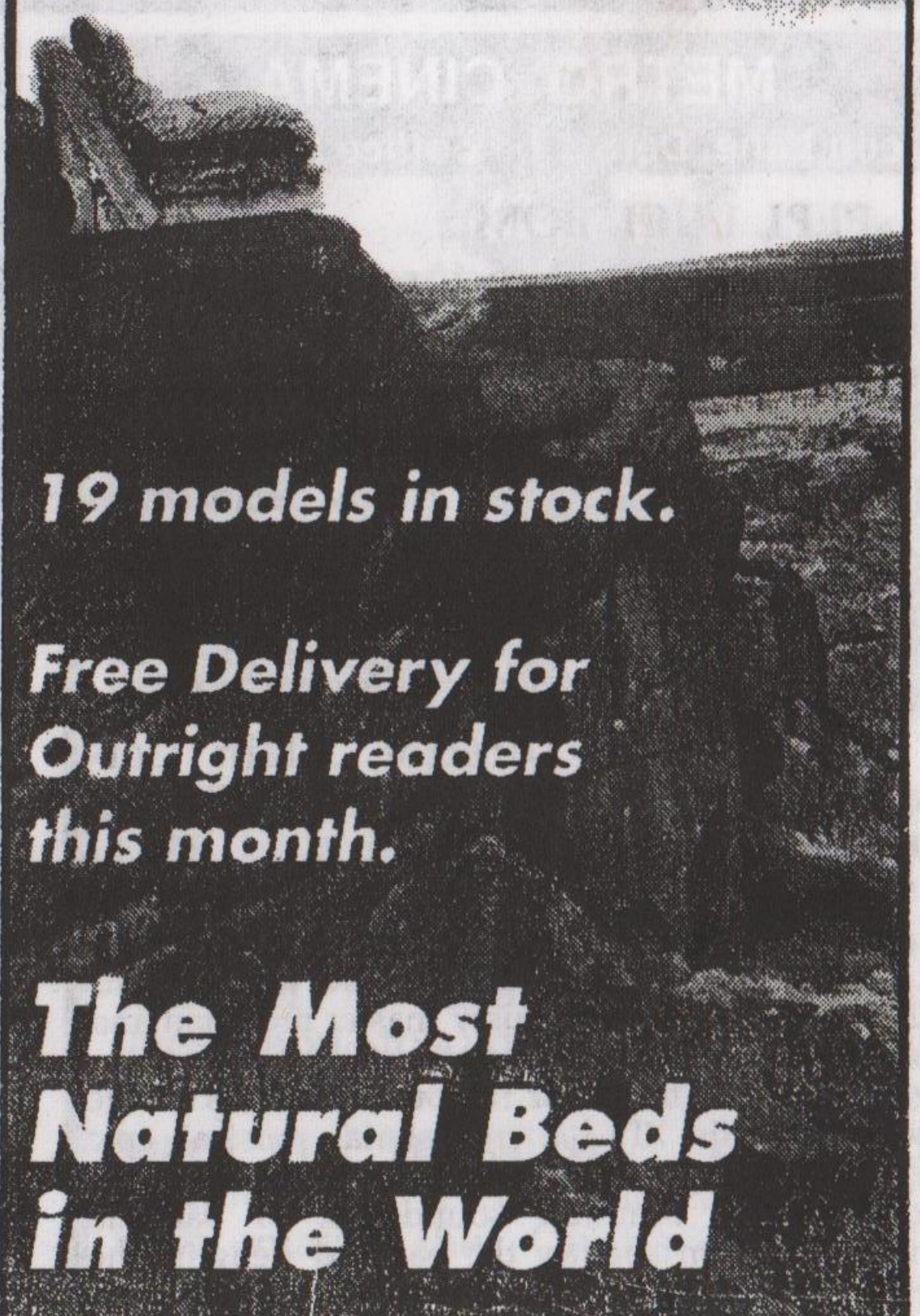

officers are 'members of the public'.

In his reply to Paddy Tipping the Chief Constable also says that "in each and every case offenders were automatically informed of their rights in accordance with the Police and Criminal Evidence Act". We know this to be untrue, as several people who were charged have come forward with information to dispute this.

OUTRAGE spokesperson, P. Ryder stated: "It seems that a lot of these cases are now being dropped when the defendants plead not guilty. We would urge all defendants, where possible, to fight their cases".

Home Office guidelines state that "No member of a police force should counsel, incite or procure the commission of a crime and all police forces should beware of the need for care to avoid plain clothes officers placing themselves in situations where accusations could be made that they have acted as agents provocateurs."

Outright believes that there is more to these cases than so far revealed and will be reporting more extensively next month.

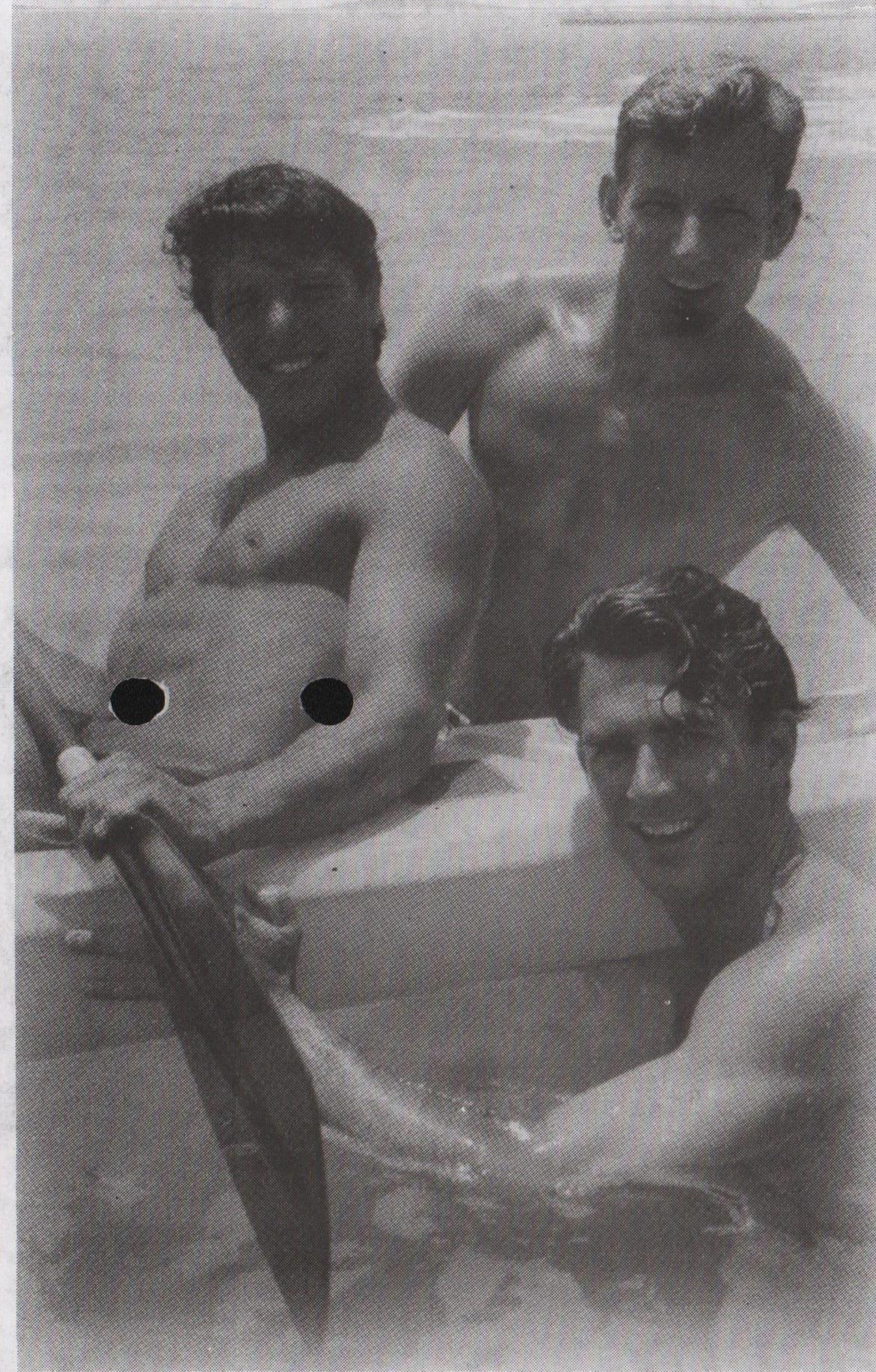

## RECORD ROUNDUP

It's been said before, but I'll say it again - 1992: What a dull year for the music industry. The charts laden with dire covers of old tracks (stand up and be counted, KWS & Undercover) and the coveted top slot bunged up with Whitney Houston's uncontrolled and hysterical mash-up of what was once a good Dolly Parton track.

It was a year in which we witnessed mindless homophobic rantings from pathetic reggae fascists Buju Banton and Shabba Ranks (rebels without a braincell) who can't see any further than the boundaries of their half-witted ghetto mentality.

But as we fast forward into '93, something to brighten up the long winter evenings (apart from crochet) is 'Home Sweet Home', a 16 track compilation displaying lantern-jawed opera goddess Joan Sutherland's talent for fluttering like a soprano butterfly through such camp delights as 'Indian Love Call', 'The Gipsy and the Bird' and 'I Dreamt I Dwelt in Marble Halls' - the latter recently ripped off and ripped up by that Diva of the Dulux ads, Enya. ### NATIONAL ORGANISATION OF LESBIAN WOMEN

KENRIC is a non-political social organisation which came into being just over 25 years ago. Some of the original members lived in the Kensington and Richmond districts in London, hence Kenric.

One of the founder members was Esme Langley, who worked for the BBC and later went into magazine publishing. Esme formed the first public lesbian group, the Minority Research Group. Sappho and Kenric both evolved from the MRG. Esme sadly died at the end of 1992.

Kenric is now nationwide, having some 1,700 members, and is open to all lesbians over the age of 18. Kenric offers an end to isolation for many lesbian women, including regional groups.

A monthly newsletter keeps members in touch and includes details of Kenric-organised events, including six mega discos a year, get-togethers, fun visits and parties, sporting activities all arranged by members themselves.

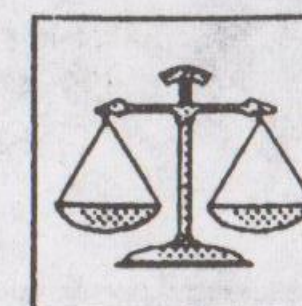
