What an irony of history has fallen on the shoulders of Lord Scarman and all those who are responsible for this inhumane and decadent world. Just as the Lord finished his so-called inquiry, he was contradicted on his own door-step by a wave of riots that have been moving all across Britain. The causes of these riots are numerous, but really they are already the refusal of this world, and to be precise, the commodity and its spectacle. It is no good looking for "outsiders" or "political agitators" - for the simple fact that those who are organised in some party or another, have really nothing to do with this critique of modern conditions -. What does a Militant Tendency activist have in common with a rioter, when he says that he wants fair policing? Nothing at all. As if such a thing could exist in 1981. In fact these MT idiots condemn looting and violence towards the police, probably because they live a comfortable life, like all middle-class swines do, and yet they too have to exist in this society of the spectacle, with its pollution. All those who condemn looting do not understand* what it means, they do not see it as a critique of political economy, they do not want to come to terms with what capitalist exploitation does to people, in other words they do not want to understand the crime of political economy** or they pretend not to understand it, so as to fog the minds of those who still believe in them and their so-called democracy. A democracy that is showing its real nature minute by minute. In the same manner the workers of Poland are also well aware of the reality of the bureaucrats who live off their wage-labour.

"The environment, which is reconstructed always more hastily for repressive control and profit, at the same time becomes more fragile and incites to vandalism. Capitalism in its spectacular stage rebuilds everything as sham and bears incendiaries. Thus its scenery becomes everywhere inflammable like all inner city areas". (The Society of the Spectacle.) The capitalist system has failed on many levels (and when we speak of this system, we also include the two headed hydra from the East: China and the USSR Empire), because it can no longer provide jobs and by the same token it has released thousands of critics into the streets, it is no wonder that the ex-stalinist Heffer and Prior and Co want to bring back all these kids into some form of employment, even if it is not profitable, for at least in this manner they will be grounded. This is what wage-labour is all about, to keep the work force trapped so that it can't criticize the prison they are in, the misery they suffer, the vicious circle this system fosters. But capitalism having failed to provide for its wage-slaves, is now confronted by a proletarian tidal wave on a scale unseen for many years.

The Labour MP who called for the resignation of Whitelaw, forgets one thing, even if this Home Sec. goes, the rioting won't stop, because the roots of the problem will still be there. And even if a Labour Party Government came back from the cold, it would be the same all over again. "Boredom is counter-revolutionary", many people are well aware of this, even if Benn, the organisers of the Anti-Nazi League, and all the maggots of the Left, prefer to forget such a simple concept, indeed a reality.

*Thatcher prefers to speak of naked greed when it comes to looters, thus she inflames the riots even more.

**No doubt many reactionaries from all parties would like to see the kind of inhumanity meted out to so-called delinquents in "Red" China, complete with mass show-trials in true 1984 style, or the treatment of Moroccan protesters who have been sent to prison for up to 10 years for demonstrating against the feudal swine Hassan 2, many were shot dead during the recent troubles there. Hassan II is a devout Moslem complete with golf club and a contradiction to his "faith": whisky.

These riots are in fact a short, sharp, shock treatment against this system of exploitation. Whitelaw's scheme of the name (SSS) against so-called delinquents has failed. The Tories think of this society as military barracks, with the discipline that is dished out in these hell holes. (Lenin also believed in such a system in his Russia of 1917, Trotsky was there to enforce the new Soviet Law, and Stalin finished the job started by Lenin, turning the entire Russian population into becoming the property of the State. This system is now being challenged in Poland, and hopefully in the rest of the Russian Empire as soon as possible.) So the "short, sharp, shock treatment" so dear to Mr Whitelaw is a failure, and it didn't take long for the soft approach of repression, to point its Labour nose, Mr Kiljoy-Silk also known as Mr Good Looks (some film directors are apparently interested in having him replace Robert Redford!) wants the end of the SSS, he is in favour of community policing, another nightmare. From the point of view of those who are against this inhumane world, either methods of repression is despicable, both create more anger, more frustration, more resentment, in fact both systems create more critique.

It is impossible in 1981 to rule Britain in a barrack manner, no one will swallow such crap, especially the young and workers. And yesterday we heard that a soldier on leave from the Irish question had been arrested for rioting. "Ways of life improve. The meaning of words participates in this. Everywhere the respect for alienation has been lost. Young people, workers, coloured people, homosexuals, women and children, take it into their own heads to want everything that was forbidden to them; at the same time as they refuse the major part of the miserable results that the old organisation of class society permitted them to obtain and to bear. They want no more leaders, no more family, no more State. They criticize architecture and they learn to speak to each other. And in rising up against a hundred particular oppressions, they in fact challenge alienated labour. What comes to be the order of the day now, is the abolition of wage labour". Lord Scarmanized can reflect on this, and all those who rule this society, but who govern less and less also. They all remind us, of people pumping water from a sinking boat, and that in the middle of a force 13 gale!

And when you think that the truth of the New Cross Massacre ^{*} has not yet reached the newsdesks, no wonder people have no faith in this system. It is riddled with lies, and the biggest of them all is wage-slavery. One could say that a D-Notice covers New Cross. It is now a State secret. When you think of all the silence that surrounds that affair, it makes you sick, -all the swines from the Labour Party say nothing, all the swines of the Liberal Party say nothing, all the swines from the SDP say nothing, and of course all the swines from the Tory Farm say also nothing, what a crew! - , it is not Lord Scar who will reveal who murdered those kids, neither will the so-called "investigative journalists" (in fact alot of the riots are not being reported, this being a way to isolate those who are fighting against this system, but it doesn't work, because the truth always travels fast, ask anyone who knows about the bush telephone, if in doubt), neither will the truth come from those who get grants from the World Church to print magazines like Race Today. Maybe more rioting is needed to get the truth about the New Cross Massacre and the murder of those burnt to death in Walthamstow, out in the open. The Times, the voice of the British Establishment printed the following: RIOT MUST NOT BE TOLERATED (23.4.81) - it is healthier to prefer LIES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. What good is the Public Order Act (1936) if thugs can burn people to death as in New Cross and Walthamstow and of course they get away with it. State terror at its best! Here we agree with Saint-Just when he said "that the present order is disorder put into laws". Obviously those who set fire to these houses did not need the 1714 and 1967 Riot Acts, they had dispersed

at the drop of a hat. Nor did they need The Prevention of Terrorism Act of 1974 (vintage) set up by the then Labour Home Sec., who today is recycled as a Social-democrat, the one and only "Cold Roy" Jenkins. It goes without saying that any State could never pass The Prevention of State Terrorism Act, these few lines will act towards that purpose.

So now we hear that another updated version of the Riot Act is to be introduced, as if these new measures could stop the anger of those who have nothing to loose by fighting this ghastly society. In fact many people are already refusing many ideologies, whether it is the Labour Party's special brew or young Asians who refuse to accept the Muslim submission that their parents accepted for centuries and the same goes for young people whose parents came from the West Indies who accepted racialism for years. And even at the recent collapse of the grip of the "Anti-nazi League" on many young people has released countless individuals from that false fight, that is to say against a mythical return of fascism in Great Britain. In fact it is Thatcher and to a certain degree the other parties which are racialist or use the racial issue to divide the working class of this country. The Nationality Bill is to a certain degree responsible for all the riots, just as police harassment, but we must look at the deeper causes which no-one speaks about, although the following lines were published in England in 1974, and in Paris in 1972, (since then we have learnt that about 30 publishers refused this book, here in London and New York, and this includes one ultra-leftist organisation and one so-called anarchist group), anyway we were lucky to find this text at the time. The British ruling class is besieged on all fronts -and the same goes for all the other crews in all countries -. (...) "Whilst the world of the commodity is disputed by proletarians to a degree of depth which their critique had never reached before, and which is precisely the only one which suited their ends - a critique of the totality -, the functioning of the economic system has itself embarked, of its own movement, on a course of self-destruction. The crisis of the economy, that is to say of the whole of the economic phenomenon, crisis more and more patent in recent decades, has just crossed a qualitative threshold. Even the old form of the simple economic crisis, which the system had succeeded in overcoming, one knows how, during the same period, reappears as a possibility of the near future. This is the effect of a dual process. On the one hand proletarians, not only in Poland, but just as much in England or in Italy, in the shape of workers who escape the union framework, impose wage claims and working conditions which already gravely disturb the forecasts and the decisions of the State economists who manage the smooth running of concentrated capitalism. The refusal of the present organisation of work in the factory is already a direct refusal of the society which bases itself on this organisation, and to this effect some Italian strikes have broken out the very morning after the day on which the bosses had accepted all the preceding demands. But the simple wage claim, when it is renewed frequently enough and each time it fixes a sufficiently high percentage increase, shows clearly that workers gain consciousness of their misery and their alienation throughout the whole of their social existence, that no salary will ever be able to compensate. (...) But it is at a much deeper level that one must understand that the commodity economy, with this precise technology of which the development is inseparable from its own, has entered into agony. The recent apparition in the spectacle of a torrent of moralising speeches and promises of detailed remedies with regard to what the governments and their mass-media call pollution, at one and the same time want to dissimulate and must reveal this evidence: capitalism has at last furnished the proof that it cannot develop the productive forces further. It is not quantitatively, as many had thought they must understand it, that it will have shown itself incapable of pursuing this development, but rather qualitatively. However quality here is in no way an aesthetic or philosophical requirement:

it is an historical question par excellence, that of the very possibilities of the continuation of the life of the species. Marx's phrase: "The proletariat is revolutionary or is nothing", finds at this moment its final meaning; and the proletariat which arrives before this concrete alternative is truly the class which realises the dissolution of all classes. "Thus things have now come to such a pass that the individuals must appropriate the existing totality of the productive forces, not only to achieve self-activity, but also, merely, to safeguard their very existence (...)
(German Ideology)." The Veritable Split in the International, public circular of the Situationist International. Lord Scarman will no doubt have sleepless nights when he reads this quote, and the same goes for Mrs T., Foot and Healoid, and all the other spokespersons who drivel on about the economy.

And the same goes for Prince Impotent who in 1978, was supposedly criticizing K. Marx whilst remaining a Royal goon, it makes you laugh. His forthcoming wedding is a slap in the face to all those who suffer in this society, another contradiction that will inflame the masses of have-nots. His wedding is nothing but the spectacle of happiness that will be seen by 900 million spectators throughout the world, but it will be overshadowed by proletarian anger, that cannot be bought off by such mediocrity, such displays worked in the thirties and fifties, but not today. George VI was in fact "the last king" of Britain. The real queen is the commodity and its reign is being challenged here and abroad on a massive scale. "The good old cause" has reappeared in England, so many thought it had vanished for ever. Proletarians no longer roam all night lost and consumed by the capitalist fire, their home is everywhere, because conflict is everywhere.

Another factor of the present anger now sweeping many parts of England, is the Irish question. Thatcher and the former prime minister of Ireland, Haughey never made their talks on Ireland public. Although it is possible to guess the content of this secret meeting. The reunification of the "two" Irelands is on the agenda. The military occupation of the North, has become a real burden (both in terms of cash and prestige abroad). But what about Paisley and his thugs? What can be done with them? He could always immigrate to Alabama along with the Monday Club, the NF & the British Movement, or to the Moon! As long as Irish people are divided by religion, the Paisleys of this world will continue to exploit this separation, and the same goes for the British ruling class, and the IRA's. But the main problem is not simply religion, but class. The rich protestants in the North do not want to give in, and the catholic working class of the North continues to be the underdog. Unfortunately the program of the Provisional IRA is nothing but a nationalist program, thus they are incapable of uniting the "two" working classes of the North. The Official IRA's program is stalinist, they would not even fight when the B-Specials invaded the Bogside in the sixties, thus people wrote on the wall IRA: "I ran away", and the Provos were born. Proletarians in Northern Ireland have many enemies: all the God peddlars, the Paisley nightmare, the Provisional leaders who demand that young IRA prisoners commit suicide for their cause, whilst they sit in Dublin, the British ruling class which has been exploiting the region for centuries, and not forgetting the bourgeois from the South, who do nothing to solve the Irish question despite all their talk. This is the situation in which many find themselves in, it reminds us of Barcelona, during the Spanish Civil War, when proletarians had to fight the fascists, and the Stalinists. But as long as people in Britain regard the Irish question as having nothing to do with them, the cancer will continue to spread. The army in N. Ireland has been using its training for eventual use on the mainland. This is a fact. How long will it be before H-Blocks are built here? The prison industry is a booming industry, and the riots could spread to the British prisons where most prisoners are locked up for 23 hours out of 24 in overcrowded cells.

Here in this modest document we have described the nightmare which many people have to endure day after day, so it is no wonder revolt is in the air, the world of prisons and wage-slavery, police and pollution, mass-media lies (half-truths), class and Royalty Coon shows, in a word the spectacular-commodity economy, a disease that many doctors wish to forget.

If you think these few lines are of some use do not hesitate to reproduce them, in any way that you think fit. If you do not like what you find here, publicize your stupidity so that everyone can have a good laugh at your own expense, and if you think you can do better than this, by all means go ahead.



- * Now we hear that black people should be allowed to join the Filth. If that scheme was to pull in some applicants (we very much doubt that) no one will be able to speak of race riots, but class riots.
- * Many people know they have no future in this world, so not only are they unemployed, but are unemployable, because more and more people do not want to sell their remaining years to some employers. No one wants to say "My employer", "My boss", in 1981.
- * Some speak of the wedding of the century, others of the riots of the century to celebrate in their way this Royal Dalek Show.
- * The riots are not being mentioned in full on the foreign media, whether, newspapers, TV or radio. The bastards of the Italian newspaper Corriere Della Sera of the 7.7.81, spoke of Texteth as a battle between blacks and whites. Maybe the Italian Establishment is scared of the British Cockpit reaching Italy. Not only they lie about what goes on abroad, they lie about what goes on in that Red Brigade infested country. This "revolutionary organisation" is in fact controlled by the Italian Secret Services, a fact many do not want to understand. The RB's always strike at the right time, at the right place. Their mission is to confuse the proletariat, and to add to all this the so-called Communist Party, says nothing about this process, because it is closely linked with those in power. A fine partnership. Those who fail to understand who the RB's are, in fact support the State terrorism now in full swing in that country.
- * Nothing will buy off those who fight this system, it is not a "collective bargaining" as the Luddites or others spoke about. For the simple reason that there is no need for wage-labour in 1981, the only need is to abolish this disease, and replace it with genuine human activity: "to each according to their needs, to each according to their capabilities", a revolutionary phrase which is becoming more and more relevant.
- * Three cheers for all Indian proletarians who protested when The Tin Lady came to that country, and who are continuing their protests today against racialism in Britain.
- * Three cheers for all those who fought against the KKK in Connecticut recently, and for all those who fought the cops in Miami, black people have no other option but to take to the streets to make their case heard, justice is just a charade, especially if you are black or poor, the cops are there to defend the property of the rich, incidentally Miami is a Mafia Haven, Frank Sinatra's favourite spot, Reagan is a good pal of Frank.
- * The ludicrous reporting of the recent riots in Britain by the Russian TV and radio, is nothing but half-truths. An accurate reporting in such a Gulag Empire is just impossible, because such proletarian joy could easily spread.
- * Sir "GoodYear" Robert Mark, the former commissioner of the Metpol, recently said that Blair Peach's skull was unusually thin (19.4.81, The Observer.) Another way of saying that the blow to Peach's head was not as hard as it has been claimed. After all a normal head hit by a police bit of lead piping should sustain such a hit. Mr GoodYear should be given an Oscar for this gem. Or does he mean that cops have thick heads.

- * Recently about 360 economists met in Britain to discuss the economic crisis. They never reached the stage of speaking of it as the crisis of the economy, thus nothing came out of their so-called conference. It was just a wank, a waste of time. Some are advisers to many governments.
- * We eagerly await what will be said about the present upheaval, all the "radical sociologists" are no doubt preparing studies to look at "the underlying causes", it will be fun to read, Mr Paul Walton, Jock Young, Laurie Taylor, Ian Taylor, Stan Cohen will soon be on TV to explain to us what it "meant". Some of them have in fact already been promoted to TV Status (Walton and Laurel Taylor). Their favourite theme is to talk about delinquents, how sabotage is not revolutionary (but capitalism sabotages the lives of almost everyone!), or they also speak in numerous books about the political economy of crime, we have a different view of this world (see page one). Everyone is going to have to show their hand, no bluff will be possible. No one is going to force them, but History itself.
- * And when you think of the so-called journalists who have said nothing about the Deptfordgate cover up, it is sickening, especially the crew from Time Out, maybe a salary of £8,500 is not enough to write about such affairs. Mr Duncan Campbell-Soup never ventured far when it came to the New Cross Massacre. After all he still has his job at The New Statesman, we laugh at the disappearance of Time Out, the little turd Tony Elliot (loves Red China, at least they work for nothing there, and they don't complain) is even worse than his staff, and yet these morons come up with this following: "Tony Elliot is not an evil person, he's only a manager wanting to manage", poor bastards, if The Turd can pay some of them £12,000 a year, that is if he manages to get his moth-eaten rag off the ground again and get the staff to accept differentials, (previously everyone got £8,500 a year), who will believe that The Little Turd is in the business for not making profits? It is not by chance that Rothschild backed him in the seventies. The staff of this shit-house are all middle-class trendies, and now since they don't get their regular income, they can't pay their mortgages, and all the rest. That is really laughable. Their counter sheet NOT should have been spelt KNOTS (the anti-psychatrist Laing knows why, he is all knotted up himself, he can't see a way out from the everyday labyrinth.) But the most good thing about the disappearance of T.O. is that the entire culture supermarket is about to collapse (they advertised in that rag), and so, countless people are being freed from the clutches of culture, we hope this process will continue, so that the critique of art starts to make its impact, the rioters of England have started to make the ball rolling, they are already far beyond the separate politics of what is called the Old and The New Left, (who will no doubt condemn what has been taking place. (No doubt many musick stars will come out to denounce the rioters, Ian Dury is already doing a concert for the Royal Wedding, others will follow).
- * All those who went to therapy to get rid of their violence and their hatred, have now realised that they can express these feelings historically, we sincerely hope that the therapy farms will be in ruins, and as for Rajneesh, the Orange guru who disappeared from Poona with the loot, we sincerely hope we see him in his Rolls-Royce. This swine wrote a book called the spectacle of death, of course he could never had written the death of the spectacle, even if he had been advised by little turds like Chris Gray (who left the 20th century to join Raj, Gray was a pro-situationist in the sixties, Gray retarded consciousness in the UK for many years. Fortunately this society produces its own gravediggers, so in the end the Grays of this world can be left to rot).
- * The funny thing about The Dung Depot (it seems a good description of the House

- of Commons, we owe this vivid renaming of the place to William Morris in his News from Nowhere. But before the inhabitants of that depot condemn rioters, they should at least not riot in the House, as they have done recently. It seems an hypocrisy on their part, (that is why you never see that horror show live on TV, because everyone would then know what went on inside that Dung Depot.) Everyone knew Nixon was a crook when they saw him on the box, and the same goes for most members of all Establishments.
- * A Night of the Long Knives could take place in the Tory Party, E. Heath is trying to make a come back, criticizing Mrs T., for her economic disasters. We wonder what Mr H., could do? In fact he could be the next transfer to the SDP team.
 - * The Reform which is in full swing in France, is a vain effort by the French ruling class, to avert proletarian revolution. Obviously the Giscard crew could not continue on the path they had taken, the dominant class can concede a few reforms to win on the totality, but France looks now as a liberal country & Britain looks like an authoritarian old Victorian country. The licensing laws here are just from another century. It does not even make sense in capitalist logic. In fact most pub landlords are all reactionaries, some have already paid the price in the recent riots.
 - * The more the internal troubles increase, the more difficult it will be for the rulers of this world to frighten the populations with their so-called nuclear war. Foot, that hysterical old fool never mentions this in his speeches. If Swift could come back from the dead, he would no doubt give some stick to Foot (who thinks he has something in common with Swift, the only similarity between him and the Dean, is that they both had a dog).
 - * As for Healeid, the slug who sits on Bildeberger and Trilateral meetings, is just a Tory in disguise, when Healey also known as Mouth speaks, he does so on behalf of all-capitalists. The Labour Party is just a big con, so many good people are conned by this mincing machine, it is time that these people who support that party, become bad towards the leaders, starting with the union bosses who keep them on a reformist course. Many union bosses get rewarded for this, they become Lords, like Scanlon, the late Feather and the ex-rioter from Glasgow, the old creep Shinwell, that is British Promotion for you. The next wave of Lords will include Lord MacCartney of Liverpool and Kodak. (Futur Minister for Musical Affairs in a coalition government between the Liberal-SDP). Some ex-punks will also be promoted to Sirs, Ladies and Lords, just wait and see.)
 - * A new Minister is about to be appointed : Minister for Riots.
 - * The anarcho-capitalists from Private Eye recently made jokes about the SUS Laws, precisely because they are not harassed like many people are by the scuffers. These buffoons forget that the SUS Laws have been enforced since the Iron Duke's time (1824), to deal with the soldiers returning from the Napoleonic Wars, who found themselves with no means of subsistence. The correspondent of the French paper Le Monde had this to say about these ex-soldiers, these Laws had to be enforced because these people were terrorising the country. Henri Pierre (HP sauce), forgets one thing, Wellington annual income was £140, 000, a considerable sum for that time, most people lived with a few pennies per week. How can these scribblers understand what goes on today if they falsify history. As for PE, they specialise in scandals, but forget that "the State is the scandal which contains all scandals". The editor of this moth-eaten rag can be found on alternate weeks in church playing with his organ. Poor Richard Ingrams, another ex-angry young man. (Colin Wilson & John Osborne are even worse than Ingrams).

Many people in Britain are fed up with their lot, and are starting to vote with their feet. For there comes a time when enough is enough. For as long as the wage racket will exist and along with it the commodity swindle, there will be discontent. And "it is because right through this hell there is a path", as Malcelm Lowry, who was writing under the volcano, well knew.

- * Lord Scarman could understand the present onslaught against class society if he gave up his Lordship, his rôle as an "impartial inquirer", it would be an unprecedented step, a poetic act that would be remembered for years to come. But we have no illusions about Lord S., we cannot see him burning his boats, his task is to save his class from the excesses of the police who enforce the flowing of commodities. It is up to him, in any case, History, a more severe judge will record his so-called inquiry.
- * The image of the gentle bobby exported abroad is now something of the past, the police is rapidly moving towards a para-military image. In any case those who have experienced the British way of policing, know that the soft image does not fit what goes on in police stations, and this has been taking place for years, the gentle image made sure this brutality never came to the surface. So many arrested people have died in police custody in the last 10 years alone, that it is no wonder no one trusts the cops.
- * And Whitelaw's other scheme of punishing the parents of those who are arrested, reminds us of Chinese Law, another way of keeping tight control over the population.
- * Let's have a look at Mr Benn also know as Saint Tomy Benn, this pathetic figure keeps fostering the "idea" that the Labour Party can be salvaged from the "right", in so doing our Saint keeps thousands of militants in that cage. This is the task of The Saint to retard for as long as possible, the hour when thousands will split from that madness, and in so doing will rediscover who they are, where they are going, for life is short, it is no good regretting when the hearse is round the corner, even if the coffin has been paid by the Labour Party. (We hear many militants have left the party, and joined a more joyful one).

THE GOOD , THE BAD & THE UGLY

No wonder Lord Scarface was laughing in Birmingham yesterday, for the police raid on Brixton gave him his break in that part of town, he quickly arrived in that district, and appeared to be on the side of the residents, the oldest ruling class in the world had shown once more what it is capable of. Residents in that area showed their immaturity when they shouted several times to Scarface: "You come back here any time you want, Lord Scarman. You don't need no police. You come back any time at all. Have no fear". So one can say that this raid was in fact well planned. Later in Birmingham Scarface said he did not know the reason for that raid. What a liar, but he knows what it has enabled him to do. He appears as the "good", the police are the bad, and the Tories are the ugly. This ploy might have fooled a lot of people, but it doesn't fool us, we know that it is through terrorism that the State conducts its operations, whether with the Red Brigades like in Italy (an appendice of the Italian State, that strikes always at the right time and at the right place, the same takes place in Spain with GRAPO, Tejero the recent coup organiser, has all the right cards in his hand, he sits happily in his luxury "prison", and "derides the Cortes while literally making all deputies (MP's) creep, and instantly it turns out that politics are not made more efficiently there than in a military prison" (Circular to all internationalists, Federation of the Dutch Region of the International Friends. June 9. 81) The Duke of Edinburgh who was supposed to be an adviser to his cousin "the tamed king", must have given him the wrong advice, for the Bourbon "monarch" now takes orders from Tejero and Co.)

The reason why CS gas was used in Toxteth has been told nowhere. Apart in veiled terms in The Economist on July 11, 1981. "On Monday, towards dawn, it seemed that the working week might begin with the insurgents creeping near the parts of the city that matter - the commuter routes to the Mersey tunnel, the Anglican cathedral, the concert hall, the central police station, itself". First the use of the word creeping is an insult towards the rioters, it fits better to journalists who are known to creep to the places where there is trouble (the stalinist reporter from the Morning Star arrived in Toxteth by taxi, he soon realised that he had nothing to do there, so he tried to take the same taxi back to where he came from, unfortunately for this creep, the taxi was already burning, he was lucky he did not roast in the car.) Those in power fear that the recent anger might spread into the ranks of those who still go to work, here it must be said that the Trade Union Moguls and the Labour Party Chiefs have done everything they could to foster the separation between the rioters and the bulk of the working class of Britain, they have saved the Conservative Government, they have saved the State from collapsing totally. That is why CS gas was used - in fact it was fired into the crowds as bullets, many people are now wounded -, to stop the rioters moving up towards what the Economist calls the commuter routes, ie. workers, who no doubt would have joined the carnival. And in so doing, the "wind of change" would have spread to the rest of the British Isles. CS gas sealed off the factories from the rioters.

The irishization of Britain is now in full swing. Thatcher and Co, have no funds for what is called inner cities projects, ie DECAY INC, but quickly found the loot to pay for all the paraphanelia of repression now available to the police. Indeed there is a boom in at least one industry: the repression retail trade. Many firms are sending their salesmen and their colour catalogues to Downing street also known as Adelfa Row. The police has become visibly what it was essentially. The "soft" cover is blown, a new era has started. The shadow of Jack Cade is everywhere: "I have thought upon it; it shall be so. Away! burn all the records of the Realm: my mouth shall be the parliament of England".

So all the idiots who sit in the House of Commons (not forgetting the Lords), have come out against the rioters, and the most despicable are the Labour Party crew. The Old Fool Foot did his usual anti-speech saying that "they (the LP) were as much determined to stamp out illegality as anybody else, but they wanted it done by fair methods which could be supported by the population and not by methods which drove a wedge between the police and the community. Everyone agrees that law-breaking must be stopped and punished." But what has Foot done to uncover the murderers of New Cross or Walthamstow? What has he done to uncover the reasons for the recent raid in true Gestapo style in Brixton? Nothing. Foot and all the Labour Party crew stink (Beith of Berwick-upon-Tweed is a disgusting creep) & keep stabbing proletarians in the back, social-democrats have done this for years, that is their task, the trotskyites of the Socialist Worker (really known as the Socialist Wanker), still vote Labour, but without illusions, what a joke! We also heard that the militants of the WRP (WARP) were also behind Texteth, you might as well say that Cromwell's Roundheads were there too. We often see dustbins full of News lines, the militants of that leninist party (the party of the working class (!)), they have been building it for years, but the walls are already cracked!) often throw away their papers, and come back to Headquarters saying "mission accomplished", for it is not allowed to come back with unsold party organs. So the militants pay out of their own pockets and throw the mags away. A few days ago we heard of another victim of police brutality. Mr Winston Rose, was arrested at his home in East London. It took eleven cops to arrest this proletarian giant. Scotland Yard said: "he choked in his own vomit", this being Newspeak for he was killed. How long will it be before those grabbed by the cops have their heads put in cages full of rats? and that before 1984.




