Report-back on Recent Events

East Midlands CND - News

This grouping brings together the local CND organisations from Nottingham, Chesterfield, Leicester, Derby, Lutterworth, Boston and Lincolnshire. It was formed in late 2002.

At the recent meeting on 12th July, many local activities were reviewed. Tom Cuthbert of Lutterworth group reported six weeks of active discussion in his local newspaper following a CND public meeting on Iraq. Geoff Lawrence of Leicester Group reported successful events surrounding the CND missile defence tour. Leaflets and petitions were distributed, and a well-attended public meeting was addressed by Alan Simpson MP and our own Carol Naughton. Maureen Maitland of Boston Group (not to say Nottingham) announced a public meeting on 25th September at Unitarian Chapel.

We are compiling details of all local media in the East Midlands to help groups in their campaigning. A very important campaigning topic in the East Midlands Area is Derby, the home of Rolls Royce Marine Propulsion Ltd. who make nuclear submarine components. There is even a nuclear reactor in Derby, parts of whose site are due for closure. There is concern about possible nuclear fuel trains diverted through the East Midlands. All the time military waste is being disposed of in Crich - locals have evidence of nuclear disposal - yet the facility has no emergency plan. More will be reported as soon as possible...

September 27th - National Stop the War Demonstration
