The SUMAC centre is at 245 Gladstone Street, Forest Fields. To get there by car you need to go up Sherwood Rise, look for Berridge Road turning on the left which is just before the zebra crossing, and take the first left up Sherwood Rise. Turn left at the top and it is on your right. Alternatively to catch a bus go to Trinity Square and look for the yellow 71 or 69 bus sign. I will be going by bus and will be there at 6.30pm. Ask for Sherwood Rise and get off at the stop after the zebra crossing. Go down Alberta Terrace, which leads onto Gladstone Street.
