But it's not a new 'problem' for Capitalism. At the beginning of the Industrial Revolution they had great



Local weavers and spinners were used to working piece rate from home, and making their own hours. They often took long weekends, celebrating what they called 'Saint Monday', and catching up with their work for the Friday.

They were still exploited, but at least had some control over their lives.

The bosses attempt to turn them into factory slaves took many years and many bitter conflicts.

For many years socialists and anarchists have campaigned for REAL work; work that is satisfying and socially useful.

But since 1945, the Labour Party has had a fascination with all things bright and shiny in their attempts to run capitalism. This attitude was most open in the 1960s with the famous 'White Heat of Technology' nonsense expounded by Harold Wilson and a certain Anthony Wedgewood Benn.

ON THURSDAY July 14th, Glasgow Women Against Pornography Action Group staged a demonstration outside the Daily Record building.

They were objecting to the daily degradation of women on 'Page 3'. Around 30 women blockaded the main vehicle entrance for two hours singing anti-pornography songs and giving the Daily Record staff as much hassle as possible.

Naturally, fearing a riot, the police were in attendance and made a brave show of strength... by ripping down the 40 foot banner which was made of solid cardboard.

Eventually Hugh Currie, the editorial manager agreed to talk to two of the women from the group (presumably Bernie Vickers, the editor, was once again too drunk to speak to them.)


Mr. Currie flatly refused to remove the 'page 3' photograph from the newspaper because, he said, "It gives the readers something nice to look at". Obviously to Mr. Currie this means showing women as willing sex objects for any man to use as he wishes. He denied that pornography encourages rape and violence against women and told the representatives of the group that his women staff had no objections to page 3, suggesting that pornography was harmless fun.

That evening, the group also attempted to jam the internal phones in the Daily Record. Although this was unsuccessful in preventing reporters phoning in copy, it has sled the workers who eventually resorted to calling the women 'dykes'.

This is the second piece of action which the group has staged against the Daily Record, and they will continue until page three is withdrawn. The Women Against Pornography Action Group is not a collection of Mary Whitehouse prudes; they want an end to rape, violence against women, and the sexual hassles which women encounter every day. Above all they want the right to choose what they do with their own bodies

40 PEOPLE took part in an occupation and demonstration at the Italian consulate in Edinburgh recently. They were protesting at the siting of Cruise missiles at Comiso, in Sicily... due to be the first in Europe.

In Sicily itself an anti-militarist campaign has been waged — making powerful enemies. Two 'Mafia' men touting machine guns broke into an anarchist centre in Comiso, warning the occupiers to "get out or face the consequences." And when hundreds of people gathered at the US base, the police charged, using tear gas, wooden clubs and studded gloves. They also fired live ammunition over the protestors heads.

The Cruise missiles are due to arrive in Britain later this year. We can only guess at 'our' Government's reaction to more determined opposition... and more determined it must be

The Greenham Common women have recently being taking action that is more than a media stunt. But it is not enough; more people need to become involved, in even more daring protests; perhaps acting similarly to the A.L.F.

Sticking flowers in fences and singing songs changes nothing. Only direct action has any *real* effect. The middle class trendies don't want to genuinely confront the government.

But it is our real enemy; missiles are just the tools of the state.
