

# STOP THE CITY



On September 29th there will be an action known as 'Stop the City'. The aim is to interrupt the workings of the City of London, in places such as the Company headquarters and financial institutions surrounding the bank of England and the Stock Exchange. Whilst the reason is 'for peace', Stop the City goes further than typical CND actions because it is attacking the heart of a system where profit and power is considered more important than health, housing and education.

We estimated that to bring the City of London to a complete standstill, it would take something like 25 000 people to block the appropriate roads and buildings. But this is not the aim of the action. The planning meetings which have been held in London thought it would be best if people arrived at 6am before work starts and that whilst some people will try to surround the Stock Exchange, others could try to reclaim the city by having a carnival with musicians and theatre groups. The 29th is the City's day of reckoning when the accounts are done and the Lord Mayor is elected. Thus, if people could be distracted from working by the carnival and their job generally made difficult, we could stop them doing their work at the most crucial time. Suggestions for action have been; encourage manual workers to stop on that day, occupy buildings have mass phone-ins to selected companies, glueing locks and 'redecorating' walls.

All sorts of groups (peace, feminist, gay, anarchist, ecology) have been involved with the planning and no-one in particular is in charge. This is a good chance for some real anti-state action because how you go about stopping the city is up to you. For example you could form your own action group and decide for yourself, or you can join in with the planned events. In general planning has been for non-violent action (that is not violence against people) but this means sabotage is expected.

Verbal Abuse? have set up a Stop the City group, who you can contact with help with press contacts, legal advice, transport (cars are good for blocking roads) and money. Planning meetings are held every Monday at 6pm at 6 Endsleigh Street. This address will also send you leaflets and informations about the action.

# CAPTAIN SWING

THESE days rural Hampshire is inhabited mostly by stockbrokers and businessmen with shiny Volvos and tarted up cottages. There is a cosy image of rustic 'niceness' which still lingers. It's easy to forget that real people once lived and died here in hardship and poverty and that there was once a tide of revolt that surged across the area many years ago.

In 1830 there was widespread poverty, caused by a decline in cottage industry and land enclosure. Many people had their land taken from them by landlords through enclosure and so, were forced to compete in an overcrowded labour market which was vulnerable to depression, mechanisation and high prices. Many had to be paid the measly 'poor relief' or be sent to the dreaded 'workhouse'. Some turned to poaching, others emigrated. In such a background of misery it was not surprising that there should be resentment towards those who had profited from the hardship.

During the summer of 1830 there were disturbances in Kent- threshing machines were smashed, there were outbreaks of arson and a flurry of threatening letters, many of them signed by a mythical character called 'Captain Swing'.

'Sir

Your name is down amongst the Black hearts in the Black Book and this is to advise you and the like of you, who are Parson Justasses, to make your wills.

Ye have been the Blackguard Enemies of the People on all occasions, ye have not yet done as ye ought

Swing.'

During the autumn the disturbances quickly spread through Southern England with outbreaks as far west as Herefordshire and as far north as Carlisle. There were more 'Swing' letters threatening dire consequences to a landowner if he didn't raise wages, there were more rick-burnings and machine-breaking. The most 'disturbed' counties were Hampshire and Wiltshire. A Petersfield report relates how a thousand-strong 'mob' passed through Chichester and Emsworth, destroyed all the machinery it could find, swept through Fareham and headed for Horndean. In the same evening a riot broke out in Havant where nine threshing machines were smashed and beer and money was demanded. On Portsdown Hill a gentleman's carriage was stopped by a crowd and dismantled.

The movement rapidly spread north and west. At Basingstoke fifty men armed with sticks arrived at Down Grange Farm demanding a wage rise. In Andover and Clatford there were riots lasting several days- it took a troop of 9th Lancers to restore order. A local magistrate told the Home Secretary that 'the peasantry have not only dictated a rate of wages not only destroyed all agricultural machinery, and demolished iron foundries, but have proceeded in formidable bodies to private dwellings to extort money and provisions - in fact, have established a system of pillage'.

In Selborne and Headley the workhouses were reduced to rubble. By the last week of November the Southampton area was 'seriously hit'. Extensive sawmills near the centre of the city were burnt down following repeated warnings. There were riots at Redbridge, Fawley and Exbury. In Ringwood 'wandering hordes from the borders of the county' (Dorset) were said to be active. Headed by a man on a white horse ('Captain Hunt', also known as James Cooper-later hanged for his troubles) 300 people marched into Fordingbridge after smashing threshing machines for seven miles around and demanded money and beer. They then demolished two nearby mills.

The revenge of the authorities was savage. The landowning judges and jurors displayed a remarkable degree of vindictiveness, even for the times.

Although no one has been killed, 19 people were executed (mostly for arson) including Henry Cook, charged with attempted murder - that is, knocking a hat off a magistrates head. Even to this day it is said that grass will never grow on his grave. 481 people were taken from their families and transported to Australia with virtually no hope of ever returning home. 644 were imprisoned. From no other protest movement of the kind (Luddites, Chartists, trade unionists) was such a bitter price exacted. So ended what has been called the 'last labourer's revolt'.

## BACK IN THE U.S.S.R.

In early August the Russian Communist Party decreed the first legal sanctions against inefficient and undisciplined workers—a system of punishments for drunks and idlers, and rewards for productive workers. The Central Committee decree allows managers to dock employees up to  $\frac{1}{3}$  one-third of their monthly wages for sloppy work, cut holidays as much as a half for absenteeism, and force unproductive or drunken employees to work for up to five months at reduced pay. Singling out 'work shirkers' as one of the major obstacles to improving the economy the decree also doubled the required notice time for leaving a job without an officially accepted reason.

Increasing labour productivity and cracking down on workers who violate 'socialist discipline' have been themes of the Kremlin leadership under Mr. Andropov. Earlier this year, Andropov ordered a purge of workers who leave their jobs to go shopping or drinking, and sent militiamen to bars and other haunts to round up loafers.

### CHINESE UNREST

19-8-83. More than 100 Chinese peasant women and children blocked roads, threw stones and attacked police at a coal mine under construction in Hunan Province, bringing working their to a standstill, according to local radio reports. ### S.A. WAR RESISTERS

The Committee on South African War Resistance is circulating a declaration of support for those people who are making a stand against apartheid militarism. Every six months, 20,000 young men are called up, and under recent legislation, they remain part-time soldiers until the year 2000. Hundreds of objectors have left the country or face unlimited imprisonment for refusing to enlist.

### PROTECTION....

Middle East Airlines and Lloyd's of London reached a compromise to continue war risk insurance provided the Lebanese carrier's three Boeing 747s do not remain at Beirut Airport at night.

### SCORCHED EARTH

The West German magazine 'Stern' has reported a 1964 plan to 'protect' the country with Atomic Demolition Munitions (ADMs). Of the 608 ADMs the U.S. possesses, 350 are stored in W. Germany. Emplacements for them are prepared along the Eastern border - and under the Lorelei rock, to dam the Rhine and make it impassable. They would be exploded in the first minutes of any war. The cities of Hanover, Frankfurt and Nuremberg would be destroyed in order to 'save' them.

### WARDERS ACCUSED

Eight warders in Nelspruit, S. Africa, have been charged with beating three inmates to death with rubber truncheons. The eight have also been accused of assaulting 34 other prisoners.

# THE WHITELEY PLAN

Those who use the language of power (Of the planners, bureaucrats, politicians, etc.) without due care imply support for the assumptions and values that such a language carries with it (words are loaded). Therefore, examples of this language have been quarantined in inverted commas. Read on.....

## THE MANIPULATOR'S DREAM-THE DOMESTICATION OF TIME AND SPACE.

On April 15th this year Hampshire County Council launched its 'draft local plan' to build a new 'community' called Whiteley around the Park Gate motorway interchange near Fareham, providing 'homes, jobs and leisure'. The plan outlines the construction of 2,600 houses based around 'neighbourhood greens', with two 'business parks' aimed at 'high technology industries'. A 'new hierarchy' of roads is also planned, linking up 'residential' and 'industrial' areas with areas where the new population will spend its leisure-the golf course and 'leisure centres'.

Whatever one's opinion may be about the proposed development, the planners and bureaucrats are unlikely to care. The decision has already been made and the plan is likely to thunder on through local 'consultation' and a 'public inquiry' towards reality. This is local democracy. It is necessary to assess the plan for its implications-how such social engineering affects and determines our everyday life and consider the role of the county planners as the controllers of the means of domestication-raising the standard of boredom over this colonised territory.

## MORE WORK, LESS LIFE.

In the late 60s the planners had the idea of building a 'Solent City' that would stretch from Southampton to Portsmouth along the course of the M27. They are a little less ambitious now, preferring instead a 'Solent Suburb'. The M27 was built not only to assist in the free flow of carbon monoxide, lead and tension producing noises, but also for the free flow of finance and investment-a ribbon of prosperity. Such 'ribbons' bring with them their own pressures upon existing communities and this is where the county planner steps in to alleviate the pressure -by adapting communities to the demands of industry and commerce. The task of the planner is threefold: to contain populations in controlled zones (the new town, city, etc.); to isolate them (a place to 'live', a place to work, a place to 'play') and disperse them (along distributor roads). Whiteley fits the bill: the housing provides a 'workforce' for the business parks and there are conveyor belts-roads-to ferry people between their divided activities - working, buying, 'spending leisure'... the community is the barracks of industry. With the modern technology of mass media, rapid transport systems, computers, economic plans, etc., the conditions of life can be shaped according to the needs of the economy-needs which have been accepted as a natural part of life, when in fact they limit life.

As servants of the economy-the enemy of human creativity- the planners can only be treated with the contempt they deserve. # THE ARMCHAIR TERRORIST ...

...Over the years a number of guides on anti-state warfare have been published, here is a quick run down of the books.

ANARCHISTS COOK BOOK: At one time outlawed, but now available in Compendium books in Camden, London. Price about £10. Large and comprehensive, gives details on making explosives, firearms, bombs etc.. plus manufacture of most drugs.

TOWARDS A CITIZENS MILITIA: Britians most popular manual, Ceinfuegos Press £2 from most radical bookshops. Based on a Swiss home guard manual, gives good advice on setting up non-heirarchical 'action' groups. Also gives ways of bomb/explosives manufacture.

WITHOUT A TRACE:Partisan Press £3.50. An excellent book for carrying out illegal or undercover activities and getting away with it. Gives methods of police detection, obtaining false identities, illegal entry and practical use of computers etc.

RADICAL INVESTIGATORS HANDBOOK: Refract£5. Less exciting than the other books but far more usefull, explaining how to find out about individuals and organisations, from a local business to the CIA. Probably the most practical way of carrying out anti-state activity.

SCHOOL STOPPERS HANDBOOK: Fuckwee Press. Eighty eight ways to stop your skool, workpalce or collage.

THE SQUATTERS HANDBOOK: ASS 40p. If you are homeless short of money etc. this will be a good short guide to your rights and the practicalities of squatting.

Most radical manuals tend to be geared towards spectacular actions, and thus are not very practical. Books like the Radical investigators handbook have much more use.

Some of the most usefull sources of information comes from the state itself. Army or police training manuals give tremendous insight into counter insurgency and riot control methods. However obtaining them takes a little ingenuity.

## URBAN LIBERATION

Trying to write about our urban environment: Houses, streets, traffic, city planning etc, in one page, is like trying to explain Einstien's theories using grunts only. However i might provoke a response and get a eloquent, imaginitive article from you, the reader. (don't be a passive consumer)

The way in which our cities are built reflects in a concrete way the nature of our society and the values of the city planners, councillors and parasite "expert's". For instance, to what extent does traffic dominate the city planning. How is the city divided up into different functions? If you take city planning of traffic and transport, you can see the deliberate way in which the authorities over the last centuary engineered the destruction of public transport. In America, for instance, most cities had an efficient electric tram system which most people used, leaving the street relatively free of cars, noise, fumes and accidents. General Motors, Firestone Tyres, Standard Oil, and others got together and brought up the Tram companies and ripped up the tracks, thus destroying the Tram system in 56 American cities, leading the way for the domination of the car. Nowadays, the vast amount of cars means that the streets are no-go areas for kids, because of the dangers. TO a large extent a community is built by friendships made when you're small. Also, a street free of traffic is an area that can be used by everyone. Apart from this, the amount of cars we have now is a waste of petrol, it is dangerous and they pump out large volumns of poisonous gases.

Milton Keynes (with its concrete cows) is a large town which took about fifteen years to build; the brain-child of a few prize winning architects. This town is a monument to the total control that is now exercised over our lives in an urban environment.

In the modern city, many thousands of people live in a small area. However, it is not a community in the true sense. Instead it consists of thousands of atomized individuals, not relating to each other but in

a dependency relationship with work and consumer society; for instance, fast-foods, tv's, and the leisure industry. As communities are destroyed the family becomes smaller and the emotional tension and pressure becomes, at times, intolerable. This creates a suitable family atmosphere suitable for modern capitalism. As people are more atomized and lonely the pressure of guilt and conformity is increased. This means that unemployment is worse, because of the dependency on work/consume in the modern city, with its shattered communities. Work for the vast majority of people is dull and boring, but unemployment is worse if people don't stick together.

As long as we continue to let the building and design of our cities to be done by the state, we will become more and more like aliens in our own homes. Take, for instance the man who was fined for painting his door a different colour in a new housing estate. The architect insisted that the colour should be as he stated (so he could win a prize, no doubt). As we become more dependent on the State and councils, they, in a way, become more dependent on our conformity. In the high-rise flats of the sixties the ruling class uprooted thousands of families and put them into vast concrete tombs. Now, many of them can no longer be used because they have been 'redecorated' by those that have to live in them. In Croxteth, young people set fire to flats and bombarded the Fire Brigade when they tried to put it out. It is a two-way process and in Croxteth the flats were redecorated as was seen fit, that is, burnt to the ground. Today, communities are being rediscovered through collective opposition to councils. Tenants involved in a battle with the council find that a new community feeling emerges. Communities formed by their struggle against authority — bad news for the bureaucrats!

## THE TORIES-WAR ON YOUTH ~ PART II

In the first issue of Verbal Assault, we published an article on the Army Youth Training Scheme which we saw as the beginnings of a potential conscription scheme aimed at young people and the unemployed. Since then the Tories have continued their attacks on young people; not content with employing youth as cheap labour under the Youth Training Scheme, Tebbit has decided that those who refuse the 'change' to go on a YTS will have their benefit reduced by 40%. Now, with the crisis of state expenditure (at least for the monetarists) the Tories, the present governmental class, see social security expenditure as a target. Since SS expenditure evidently is up to 30% of the total expenditure and because at the moment to reduce benefits to families and single people over the age of 18 is politically unpalatable, those aged 16-18 are, in the Tories eyes powerless. Evidently the proposals are to reduce benefits by £7 or £8 thus reducing benefits to £7.80 per week for 16 and 17 year olds (and to £12.55 for an 18 year old). The 18 year olds get £3.10 a week towards their parent's housing costs.

The aim is to reduce state expenditure by around £100-200 million (peanuts compared with general defence expenditure). This move would hit 750 000 young people.

The mythology behind all this is the 'work ethic'. Thatcher (ex-milk snatcher, now youth strangler) said 'They have a lot of money in their pockets and some of them - not all of them, by a long chalk - some of them learn a way of life which they should never have a chance to learn.' Well Thatcher has been living in Murdoch's cloud cuckoo land for some years, but for sheer unadulterated gibberish, that takes some beating. Well, dear Mark and Carol may have nice well-paid jobs, which they don't appear to have done much bike-riding for, and they probably (at least for some of us) have too much money in their pockets but they are hardly typical. Anyway, the Tories are as usual full of contradictions - a party praising the 'family' as an institution proceeds to create a situation where unemployed youth are encouraged to leave home so as to screw money out of the state. No doubt this hope-brained scheme will lead to more squatting and more

theft and crime generally. Three things the Tories don't usually advocate.

## THE PEACE MOVEMENT

The peace movement in Britain today can be divided roughly into the following sections:

1. C.N.D., Y.C.N.D: the national organisation with its regional groups and paid-up members. The press uses the term 'C.N.D.' for any peace movement action whether it was done by them or not. Also the independents like families, lawyers, teachers and screws against the bomb.

2. The Peace Camps: These are the centres of direct action at the moment and they vary a lot in their attitudes and what they are willing to do.

3. Anti-militarist groups: They vary from the Christian pacifists like the Quakers to anarchists like London Greenpeace.

This is a rough division because the peace movement is quite fluid and it would be wrong to over-classify it. The view points vary considerably, but on the whole they call themselves 'non-violent'. Within 'non-violence' you have Christians (from Quakers to Catholics), Budhists and the Eastern religions, a strange mixture of feminism, 'non-violence' and pagan ideas, your liberal and socialist middle class who do nothing but call themselves 'non-violent' anyway, and the 'greens' (which vary from some Tories to anarchists). There are, outside the 'non-violence' grouping, anarchists who wish to see an end to violence but would not call themselves 'non-violent'. I, personally, do not agree with 'non-violence' even though I would not use violence against people, not at this stage of events. I will try to put across my ideas as to why I think 'non-violence' is a dead-end.

Firstly, there is a blatant contradiction in the feminist and C.N.D. 'non-violent' attitudes. Feminism, as I understand it, is about rediscovering womens anger and also self-defence against rapists, which helps women to walk confidently down the street knowing that they can do a severe injury to gorillas who attempt to rape them. C.N.D. resolved that it should be 'non-violent' whilst advocating a non-nuclear defence. Aren't guns, tanks and howitzers instruments of violence?

Other advocates of non-violence are less contradictory and would argue for a non-violent defence against aggressors. However, I don't believe it would be possible to throw off unwanted rule by non-violence alone. Non-violent resistance in any struggle for freedom counts for about 80% of resistance but an essential part of overthrowing armed aggression is the creation of no-go areas for the authorities. This does require violence which could take the form of riots or guerilla resistance. I feel that non-violence is impractical and lets face it, "non-violence" is a moral philosophy rather than a practical method in the eyes of it's advocates.

Ghandi is often quoted; a man who has been elevated to a saint-figure. There is a tendancy for pacifists to create "heroes" of non-violence such as Ghandi, Martin Luther King, the Wimin of greenham, etc as a moral example of how we should all behave. Ghandi achieved much by turning the national liberation struggle in India into a mass movement. Originally it consisted of the up-and-coming Indian middle class and intellectuals who waged a terrorist campaign, not involving the mass of the people..

THE PEACE MOVEMENT (Cont.)

By concentrating on the heroic actions of a few, whether violent or non-violent, you cannot encourage the growth of a mass-movement which involves everybody. This, unfortunately, is being done at the moment. In other words they are stifling non-violent action. 'Non-violence' is, therefore, more than a tactic to be used, it is a moral philosophy and so it expects people to adhere to it. At Torness, a large body of pacifists forcibly stopped the invasion of the power station by a group of protesters. In Eastliegh, when Hestletine came, a small group of protesters of the 'non-violent' sort handed round a leaflet which asked people to be silent, to hand Hestletine a bunch of flowers and if you didn't want to do that, could you please go ~~xxx~~ across the road and look like an idiot?! Why doesn't Peace News publicise the 'stop the city' action and the animal liberation demo at Porton Down? Fucking pacifist police!

Non-violence is therefore an anti-human philosophy when it takes over a demonstration and makes it purely ~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ symbolic. Pacifists have been known, on many occasions, to grass on people who they see as being violent.
