

NCB'S 'BACK TO WORK' LIES

The NCB has been falsifying the 'back to work' statistics by the following means:

- non-miners have been bussed into collieries past picket lines
- miners from other pits in other areas have been brought into border-line pits
- new recruits have been secretly taken on to boost the figures
- wages have been paid (on paper only) to relief workers who have been distributing coal to hospitals and pensioners.

The NCB have also been sending officials around to striking miners to offer bribes to return to work.

STATEMENT OF ROBERT MALONE

19 The Circle
Denderhall

STATEMENT of Robert Malone

I am aged 34 of the above address. I was one of a party of pickets who travelled down from Scotland to Ollerton on the 25th April 1984. I was lodged at 7 Maid Marian Way with Mr Spencer, the owner.

I picketed Ollerton Colliery at shift times on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. I was not involved in any trouble on the picket line. On Friday morning at 4.50 a.m. I left the house I was staying in to go as usual to the picket line at Ollerton Colliery. I walked across the fields to the main road which is called Whinney Lane and walked in the direction of Ollerton Colliery when a car stopped containing two men in the front seats. The passenger wound down the window and said to me "Are you going to the picket line?" I said "Yes". He said "Jump in, we'll give you a lift up". I got in the rear door on the passenger side and in a short while I thought to myself we didn't seem to be going to the Colliery for I was in some difficulty because I was not familiar with the area and I'd always walked. I had never gone by car. When I'd been in the car about ten minutes I knew something was out of order. The car stopped for some reason - I think at junction - and I tried the back door. I couldn't open the door for some reason and I thought of winding the window down to try and open it from the outside, but the Driver turned round and said "Just relax Jock". They just drove and drove. We left the housing scheme and went out into the country for about 20/30 minutes. The two men got out of the car and one of them opened the back door and said "Get out of the car and put your hands on top". I got out of the car and I knew these men were Police Officers. I did as I was told, faced the car and put my hands on top of it. The one on my right spoke to me and I turned my head to look at him. I then felt a thump on my left hand side at the bottom of my ribs. I staggered and looked to see where the blow had come from and the Policeman was hitting me again. This blow caught me in about the same place and I fell down on my backside with my left leg straight out in front of me and my right leg bridged. They had a black truncheon or cosh they hit me twice on the knee and on the inside of the thigh. One of them said (the one who had been in the passenger seat) "It's a waste of fucking time lifting you'se Jocks - this is the way to treat you'se". I was on the grass looking up at them and the one who had sat in the passenger seat said "You have found your way down here and you will find your fucking way home". They got in the car and drove off at speed.

I managed to get up and walked in the opposite direction and eventually found my way to that place described on the accompanying map. From there I found my way eventually to the house I was staying in. Mr Spencer sent for a Doctor and He

suggested I should report the attack to the Police but I told him it was a waste of time as, in my opinion, it was the Police who had attacked me. My injuries were photographed.

I have no facilities for doing anything down here. I have no support down here. I therefore give permission for the person who took this statement, whose name I do not know, to forward it to such a place as he thinks will do most good, so that it can be fully investigated.

ROUND AND ABOUT THE MINERS STREET - HIT AND RUN TACTICS

Guerilla tactics were used in the raids on Doncaster NCB Area Office and NCB property at Harworth and Silverhill collieries. Police vehicles, coal lorries and the cars of scabs were attacked and damage was extensive. At Silverhill many NCB office windows were smashed and cars damaged. At Doncaster over 150 took part in the raid on the Area HQ, causing extensive damage. There were only three arrests. Nine cops were injured during scuffles at Harworth. Later a police spokesperson said that they thought the operation was well planned and feared that the defensive tactics had taken on a new phase. According to some press reports those that took part in the raids numbered up to 1000 and knew exactly how to go about things, acting efficiently and with precision.

At Bilston Glen, Scotland, 3000 pickets confronted cops and when 50 were arrested, pickets laid siege to the local police station until all their comrades were released.

At Parkside Colliery, Lancs, over 1000 pickets managed to prevent 100 scabs from getting to work; many police and NCB vehicles were attacked.

In the Garw Valley, S Wales, miners erected a barricade at the entrance to the local pit. Local people came out to support the miners as police dragged some to waiting vans. Pickets attempted to rescue prisoners and attacked a police

van. A crowd gathered and surrounded one group of cops who were holding the prisoner and forced them to let the prisoner go.

At Hawthorn, near Durham, a railway line from the pit to the nearby port was ripped up by persons unknown.

A miners radio has been active over the last three weeks, as far as I know they have not been caught. They have interrupted the local radio station 'Radio Trent', calling on working miners to join the strike.

A scab at Easington colliery in Durham was turned back for a week despite the help of our boys in jackboots before they finally smuggled him in on 25/8. Miners etc (numbering 250) responded by trashing the buildings and management cars. Police donned riot gear and set about their usual business. This is the first time the riot version have been let off their collars over the miners dispute in the North East.

Three policemen were hospitalized who got in the way when miners threw stones at privately contracted trucks, at Ellerbeck colliery Lancashire.

This is not a comprehensive list, just a taster. Unfortunately, there has been a sharp drop in reports concerning these tactics. A news blackout occurred after the '81 riots. They'll only tell you what is 'safe'.

A N A R C H I S M

Anarchism was first used as a word to describe a philosophy by P.J.Proudhon in the 18th century but libertarian ideas have been understood long before him. You might say that Lao-Tse's poems (2000BC) were the first recorded expression of libertarian ideas:

"Experience teaches that none can guide the community;
the community is a collaboration of forces;
as such, thought shows, it cannot be led
by the strength of one man.
To order it is to set it in disorder;
To fix it is to unsettle it."

Politics, in the main, is totally boring because it usually means the ritual arguments between politicians and parties, yet it is this process, known as politics, that decides our future. Nothing really changes in any fundamental way that is meaningful and direct - this is how anarchists see politics. Anarchism is not a sect that advocates an obscure set of ideas, because it asks the first and most fundamental question of all politics: is government necessary? Few really know why they need government and are rarely required to ask, so by this token, most politics can be wholly dismissed because it rests on a huge and unassumable assumption.

Many would agree that the East-West divide is artificial and that we as ordinary people have no reason to blow up ordinary Russians East-Germans etc or the Chinese. The harder you look at the behaviour of the Soviet government and the Western states the more it is to find any real difference and at the end of the day, the false conflict only serves to strengthen the governments control 'for National Security reasons'. Adolf Hitler and the Third Reich is regarded now as a great evil - the bad government. Dictatorial despots and bad leaders are blamed for the worst excesses of government thus leaving the idea of government intact and making 'democratic' govts look good. But the truth is many 'ordinary' Germans didn't regard Hitler as being so different and neither did the British government, in fact they were really rather compatible. When a liberal/democratic government is rejected by its subjects, despite its more subtle and more pervasive persuasions it switches over to military rule. If modern government is any more 'advanced' it is because it can achieve this switch with greater ease. Northern Ireland is a good example, looking at the Diplock courts and military rule; (today towns are planned under the guide of the military-Lisbon, N. Ireland). If you need further proof you can read the governments National Security plans for a state of emergency. Government must be seen as it is and we should not be confused by its different flavours. You either give credibility to government solutions or you don't.

Government solutions to world problems have never produced a beneficial result and most times they just increase problems. But it is the running of the economy that decides how resources are used: what purpose products have, working conditions, how boring it is (very rarely interesting), poverty, wealth etc. etc. etc.. The economy reduces many of our relationships to 'things' even 'things' are stripped of quality since they can, in turn, be reduced to money; as can most things: such as rare species, the environment, our health, time, energy and spirit. What's good for the economy is usually bad for mankind: a starving Ethiopian has a great need for food but since s/he has no 'demand' s/he starves. Commodities have become supreme and we are constantly encouraged to consume this or that product above all else. The best commodities are those that dominate our lives such as cigarettes or the 'latest craze'. Artificial qualities and needs are created for products: a cigar with 'six appeal', 'men can't help acting on impulse', or sultanas that go crunch.

Huge bureaucracies are symbols of bad organisation (they are bureaucratic!) and only stifle creativity.

In the end we must choose between the permanent crises and ~~wars~~ that government and the economy create, or choose to run our own lives; in a world with no god or master ruling above the needs and desires of mankind.

MORE NEWS IN BREIF

POLICE BOOT

A police officer kicked a man so hard in the face that the sole of his boot came off. Believe it or not the 57 year old man was charged with criminal damage to a police boot. The charge was later dropped!!

SOUTH AFRICAN RIOTS

11 people killed - all blacks. Rioting occurred in black townships south of Johanesburg. A bomb exploded in the ministry of internal affairs. Sharpeville had worst rioting. The deputy mayor was hacked to death. Police fired live rounds at demonstrators (School kids)

NOT PLAYING BY THE RULES

Looking at the miners strike, two things stand out clearly: Firstly, the miners themselves have realized through their tactics that only one side is going to win; Secondly, where the British state lies. - A barbaric parasite resting heavily on the backs of British working class people; as the sworn enemy of justice, freedom and humanity, and as an institution that will go to any extent to maintain its control over YOU AND ME.

Behind the mask of 'democracy' is the face of brute force. We live in a slave camp under the flag of freedom. It is this fact that resistance to the government or any other government will expose - you are free so long as you do nothing. Miners hit squads attack scab lorries and firms, rip up rail tracks, cut down power supplies, attack cop shops in large well organize groups. The 'liberal press falters and stops printing the news (re. Sarah Tisdall) like after the '81 riots. The TUC will do its best to take contol of the strikes, and sell it out to the bosses. The leftist eunuchs can only offer hot air, as they are out to create power for themselves, and flog their tatty rags and front organisations. The management in conjuction with the press will go to any extent to create a 'back to work' movement to break the strike. None of this should surprise anarchists and ~~neither~~ should the aims and principles of the strike be lost. There is a choice between working down the pits or living on the dole without hope of life beyond subsistence, in destroyed communities. But in strike action, miners, especially the young, have found there is more to life than the grim alternatives offered to us by our bosses, in the solidarity, the communal way of life, the friends to be made, and living in the open air fighting back against the futility of life under capitalism, where the Economy is judged to be more important than the human spirit. But lets not glorify the miners strike as the only and final fight against Thatcher, we have no political milage to be gained. The only thing that will help the miners after we have given our passive support, is our active resistance.



Shop Workers Pay Conditions Holidays And Extortion

During the latest world repression many (most ?) bosses have decided to pay their employees below the legal minimum wage. The following table shows the minimum hourly wage in England and Wales outside London (London min wages are approx 4% higher).

Overtime rates apply on Sunday + Bank Holidays as follows +

Up to 4½ hrs -- 9hrs pay

4½ to 8 hrs -- I6 hrs pay

More than 8hs-- double pay for all hours worked

Overtime rates are also payable for more than 39 hrs worked in any one week at time and a half for every extra hour worked.

If you work over 9 hrs per week, not including overtime, you are entitled to holiday pay. Your holiday money must be paid on the last payday before your holiday but you have to give 2 weeks notice before taking a holiday. The minimum holidays are as follows --

DEDUCTIONS

Employers may not touch your wages except for the removal of national insurance, tax deductions, pension contributions, signed contracts (SUBS), and signed contracts under sections I,2+3 of the truck act.

All workers (except outside workers) can, and should, refuse to work in temperatures below 60.8°F after they have been in that place for one hour. Any heating device provided must not give out offensive or injurious fumes. Another entitlement is adequate supplies of fresh or conditioned air.

IN A FACTORY OR WORKSHOP

All gangways must be clearly marked and clear of all obstructions. All milling, grinding, cutting, pressing, stitching, and slicing machines must have guards or (adequate ?!!) operator safety precautions.

All flammable fluids and chemicals must be marked as such. Goggles and breathing filters must be provided when working with blasting machines, fibrous and powdered chemicals or materials.

If the place in which you work does not observe the above or you think that the place in which you work is unsafe or unhealthy then call the local factory inspector who can be found in the local phone book under "Health and safety executive".

Fight fire with fire.....

HEROIN

The recent media-touted upsurge in Heroin (Diamorphine) abuse has, according to our very own Echo, reached Southampton. This "epidemic" must be viewed in its' real and wider context - post 81 riots Britain. The glut of cheap "smack" currently on the market is directly related to the heartfelt refusal of inner city youth to take anymore government crap in the summer of '81. Large amounts of the debilitating drug are finding their way onto inner city housing estates and into the veins of the kids whose areas were the focus of proletarian discontent.

Following the riots Thatcher and cronies, deeply worried by opposition to their crimes, co-operated with fascist Meathead Gulteri (also having prole problems) in staging the futile, murderous spectacle of war in the Fucklands. From atop the mound of corpses, British and Argentine, she hoped to gain a much needed breathing space through the blind and rancid nationalism created by the war. However the ruling class realizes only too well the growing danger they face from inner city insurrection and the young proletarians who have even more right to feel alienated in '84 than they did in '81. One of their solutions to this potential source of interruption to their money/power games is to neutralize the rebellious youth with heroin.

Britain has one of the oldest and most successful ruling classes in the world. They've gained, as you would expect, vast experience in dealing with their most crucial problem - controlling the proletariat for their profit and gain. The current use of heroin to keep the unemployed harmless is certainly not the first time Britain's ruling elite has used opium or opiates (of which heroin is one) for this or similar purposes. Britain waged the opium wars (1839-42 and 1836-60) to force Manchu China to accept the import of opium, cede territory such as Hong Kong and open China to imperialist domination. Our ruling class showed its' true colours - as a large scale "pusher" fighting a war for the right to peddle their resistance weakening drugs. Apart from the profit to be had from the misery of the addict, the British had another major reason for wanting opium to be readily available in China - to destroy the will and weaken the resistance of the traditional Chinese warrior class who were the main targets of these peddling operations. The fact that these same tactics are now being used against the British working class shows how far the class war has progressed and how much our rulers' fear insurrection on the streets and particularly the inner city areas. This particular tactic is not foreign to the American empire, whose ruling class used it in the 60's. The CIA's contribution to heroin production in Indo-China is well documented. They tried to build up political support with wholesale purchases of the opium crop from local tribes people and close co-operation with the so-called "opium lords". The product was refined and then distributed amongst Americas youth in the attempt to weaken the anti-war movement. Those who died from the drug were just as much victims of the war as the soldiers and civilians who died in Vietnam itself.

As with many other commodities, there is a world glut of the heroin market. But this is only allowing the dealers to invest in our misery - distributing the drug on the cheap, in order to reap the rich rewards of addiction and rising prices in the future. Easy availability and low prices are having a devastating impact on some working class housing estates. In north Southwark, London, there are 40 or more dealers and over 1000 regular users; in Liverpool it has been reported that half of all 14-25 year olds on some estates have used heroin. From the perspective of middle class liberalism this is just another problem of the inner city. But this only disguises the effect of heroin addiction in suppressing the most desperate section of the working class.

Addiction is not an "aberration" from the norm of capitalist society, but an extension of one of its more important features. Capitalism nurtures compulsive consumption in all our spheres of activity. Virtually all the goods and materials we need to live are available only as commodities, as objects to be bought. All "businesses" must maximise their sales in a market where all commodities are competing for our attention. Obviously, advertising and sales pitch play a major part in this process, but people often internalise it: the compulsion to buy can spring from our attempt to overcome lack of personal fulfilment: in our alienated existence, we substitute the act of "having" or "possessing" for "doing" or "being". Drugs such as heroin take commodity fetishism one stage further, with physical addiction: it becomes impossible for our bodies to function without a particular commodity, monopolising the user's physical and mental needs. In the words of

William Burroughs, "Junk is the ideal product..... the ultimate merchandise, no sales talk necessary. The client will crawl through a sewer and beg to buy... The junk merchant does not sell his product to the consumer, he sells the consumer to his product." Beyond a certain level of addiction, there is no limit or control. Drug sickness is to lie, cheat, inform, do anything to satisfy the craving. Recent alarm in the lie-sheets concerning heroin is usually exclusively concerned with the shocking story of how middle class respectable parents had discovered their son was taking a degrading and dangerous drug totally inappropriate to his class and background. Scummy rags such as the daily mail couldn't give a toss how many working class kids died of smack overdoses but became hugely irate and upset about a handful of peer's brats "slumming it" on heroin. When "public concern" is focused on working class youths on drugs the "concern" is not for the health or the misery of the addict but rather over the robbery, mugging and prostitution that supports the habit.

The pyramid of junk is the pyramid of the consumer society, one level eating the level below, those at the top allways fatter than those at the bottom - the addicts are always given away by their emaciated looks. Those who remain at the bottom are forced to steal to keep up their habit, generally from fellow proletarians. Other users become pushers to make the money to satisfy their need. As such they must find more customers to survive, and the capitalist ethos is reproduced in the drugs underworld. Selling becomes more of a habit than using.

Unemployed youths are able to see through many of the illusions which help others to get by from day to day. They know the system has nothing to offer them. They are taking the brunt of the crisis. The choice is stark: fighting back or escapism. When the opportunities for fighting back - such as during the riots of '81 - are limited, or not realised, escapism, particularly through booze or drugs becomes more frequent. At the same time, the corrosive influence of heroin undermines personality. It acts to quell revolt before it takes place.

Groups have emerged to combat the heroin pushers on some estates where addiction is widespread. Sometimes they take open reactionary positions, such as calling for more policing. But in other cases, where the groups show a greater sensitivity to the complexity of the problem, they themselves came up against the forces of the state. For example in Dublin where a successful anti-heroin campaign was commencing the police stopped in to reestablish their authority. The police called for the disbandment of the vigilante groups, claiming that they were better able to deal with the problem. But "deal" is the right word. Wherever drug pushing is profitable, the police get in on the racket somewhere along the line. By recycling drugs seized in raids, drug squad and customs officers can top up their wages. The police allow favoured pushers freedom to pursue their vile business in exchange for bribes or for tip-offs (which means prison for many forced into crime and other proletarians who are in the wrong place at the wrong time). Junkies too are notorious sources of police information. Furthur up the criminal heirarchy, police involvement in the rackets keeps them informed on what is going on; in exchange for a piece of action, the police protect their criminal concessionaries by launching the occasional anti-drugs campaign to wipe out any competition arriving on the scene. The sanction of arrest allows them to make sure that the drugs market runs smoothly and profitably. The impact of the anti-heroin campaign on organized crine in Dublin and elsewhere has proved to be a defeat for the police.

The use of heroin to supress people is only the illegal mirror image of the government's massive legal prescribing of tranquilizers and depressants to the vast mass of depressed and dissatisfied, usually older, people. Not to mention the even viler use of dangerous drugs on mental patients and "ordinary" prisoners (the liquid cosh) against their will. Those in power need downers, tranquilizers, opiates etc. to keep all the alienated and unfulfilled of society from getting too violent and expressing their dissatisfaction. This dissatisfaction would be ultimatley directed at the criminals in power who run our lives. Those who shoot "H" into themselves will one day shoot lead into those who make our lives miserable and devoid of value.
