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## L.K.J IN DUB: LINTON KWESI JOHNSON : ISLAND RECORDS ILPS 9650

The album contains eight tracks which are made up of four from Forces of Victory and four from Bass Culture. They little resemblance to the original versions due mainly to a use of dub and a lack of words on all tracks except Iron Bar Dub the reworking of Sonny's Lettah. This means the album has to stand up solely on musical content which it does handsomely. This seems a strange route for L.K.J to take because he was known for delivering lyrics live with no music so he is moving from one extreme to the other.

L.K.J uses a whole host of backing musicians numbering sixteen in all and featuring such big names as Dennis Bovell on keyboards and Rico on trombone. The album itself is excellent. The first track to hit you is Iron Bar Dub, a song of intense emotion which tells of Police brutality in the form of a letter written home to a mother from a son who has witnessed the violence.

The whole album is held together by some great bass lines from Floyd Johnson and Vivien Weather. Other tracks to catch the ear are Peach Dub which opens with an amazing trombone solo and Brain Surgery Dub in which the trombone is also heavily favoured. STEEN
