Remember Jake Prescott and Ian Purdie? They were tried last year for the same set of bombings as the Eight are accused of. In spite of the incompetence of the defence lawyers and the bias of the judge, the jury were not entirely duped and found Ian not guilty and Jake not guilty of actual bombings. They did find Jake guilty of conspiracy to bomb, and for this the judge made up for the jury's sense of justice by sending Jake down for

Six of the Eight were busted last August and the other two late last year. All but three are still in the nick: 10 months in prison without trial. Three have been granted bail, exiled from London and put under house arrest.


