# WIMMINI BEWARE!

It cannot be stressed enough how dangerous Depo-Provera can be. It sounds such a great idea - 3 monthly injection, nothing to worry about, no mess no bother. Whatever lifestyle women lead it'd be great not to have to think about it or have any niggling doubts every time you have sex. "Is it safe?" . Tt feels like that question has been asked for centuries, about the contraceptives that there are. There's always the same answer...Not all contracep -tives are 1009 safe. Neither are they healthy. Think about it, putting all those chemicals into our bodies, either by the Pill or by injection can't be doing us any good?

I remember watching a documentary some years ago where a woman, in the UK was talking about having the injection and how her periods had stopped completely. I thought they'd banned it!

Depo-Provera along with many other drugs are tried out on Third World countries, the 'guinea pigs' of the multi-national pharmeceuti-cal industries. Now it seems with increased awareness, some communities and groups are refusing many of these drugs (Women in Bangladesh now refuse to be injected with D-P.

But, since April '84 D-P has had a long term licence for use in this country. Upjohn, the notorious multi-national compamy have been encouraging doctors to pro-mote it.Of course the same racist attitudes that used wymmin in the Third World as experiments, are used in this country on Black and Asian wimmyn. It must be noted that for them D-P is

useful if they don't want their husbands or family to fand out.

Depo-Provera has been offered to womyn in Bristol for quite a while now(e.g. Hogg, Hogg & Hogg in Kings-wood) and I know that a young pregnant woman had been off -ered it without knowing about the side effects or the possible danger to her child.

As well as Upjohn's Depo -Provera there are at least 4 other injectable contra

-terat or Noriget) manufac
-tured by Schering and only
available in Britain for
testing purposes. It has
similar adverse effects as
D-P but is injected every
2(insteadeof 3) months. So
beware if you are offered
this.

## .... THE STORY OF THE PACIFIC REGION

This article written about the Pacific Region is intended as both a sharing of some information which seems scarce here in Europe and also to voice a concern that if we are to be successful in bringing about true peace then we cannot afford to ignore any part of the problem.

People striving for peace here in Europe must recognize the role that the Pacific Region plays in the global nuclear strategy and understand the immense importance of what the Pacific Peoples are contributing to world peace. It is no overstatement to say that if we can make the Pacific truly pacific (peaceful) again we will take a huge step towards Global Peace. Although European Peace Peoples are attempting to look beyond their own immediate problems to conceive of the problem as something greater than Cruise and Pershing Missiles this process is slow. As the nuclearization of the Pacific Region is directly linked to the nuclearization of Europe and thus affects the lives of all Europeans there is a danger of being single focussed on the Euro-missiles. We can so easily forget to look behind the screen that the media presents us with.

The Pacific Region, one third of the Earth's surface and consisting of Australia, New Zealand; Japan, the Philippines and Hawaii as well as the North and South Pacific Islands, is that area of the world that has been, and continues to be, inflicted with every aspect of the nuclear power and armaments industry. From Uranium-mining to Nuclear Weapons Deployment this includes uranium-processing, nuclear power plants and 'fast breeders' waste dumping, testing of nuclear weapons and missiles, Command/Control/Co-ordination/Navigation and Intelligence Facilities, and the Transport and Stationing of nuclear powered and armed submarines, ships, and airplanes. And above all this is the colonial imperialism and oppression of a gentle, peaceful people, the indigenous peoples of the Pacific, now nomadic refugees in their own world and forced to live in slums where life is meaningless and diseased. It is this colonial control by European and American governments that allows the actuality of a nuclear war, now 38 years old, to be practiced against the Pacific Peoples and allows that region to become a First-Strike Target in the event of Global Nuclear War.

The reality of the Pacific Region is in direct contrast to that portrayed by the tour -ist posters. The reality is the DARK SIDE of PARADISE!

Although it is not possible here to go into detail on each aspect of the nuclear cycle as found in the Pacific Region the opportunity is taken to point out that whilst it is in the Northern Hemishere that the main nuclear armed Nations lie it is in the Southern Hemisphere and Central Pacific that the production and support of the weapons systems are to be found. One should remember that all parts of the nuclear cycle are inextricably linked, no one part can be ignored.

The nuclear cycle begins with Uranium Mining. Australia, a rim country of the Pacific Region, has 20% of the western world's reserves of high-grade uranium ore and although at present it only supplies 2% it has contracts with many European countries with the USA, Canada, Japan and South Korea and is indirectly linked with many others. Australia also supplies 33 other strategic minerals the most important being Zircon, needed in the nuclear-fuel cycle and thus directly linked with nuclear weapons, of which it has 97% of the Western World's supply. Although there are other places with--in the Pacific Region supplying these primary ores of the armaments industry Aust--ralia, with the world's largest deposits, has a particular responsiblity. There are many problems associated with uranium mining but the most unique to Australia is the oppression of the Aboriginal People. The blatant destruction of the environment and the desecration of their sacred places which has occurred throughout the 200 years that Australia has been colonized by white Europeans, and continues today, has caused the destruction of much of the Aboriginal culture and economy and is aiming towards the total elimination of a whole people. Uranium-mining is a major and effective step towards that goal.




The next step, for the Pacific Region, in the nuclear cycle are the nuclear power stations and 'fast breeders'. Located in theUSA, Korea, Japan, China and the Philip-pines these stations are polluting the Pacific Ocean and affecting all life in that region. In addition to this threat is the possibility of building ocean platforms for nuclear power plants which is presently being researched. There is no need to stress the problems arising from these power industries because they are found in Europe too

From the power industries however come nuclear waste and it is the dumping of this in the Pacific Ocean that causes a problem unique to the region. Since nuclear waste dumping began in 1946 with the USA government extremely high levels of radiation have occurred in many places, often polluting rich fishing waters and thereby entering the food-chain of the Pacific Community. In 1981 the Japanese government, despite wide spread protest from other Pacific Countries, began dumping it's waste in the Northern Mariana Islands ( south of Japan). But the USA and Japan are not alone, all the main nuclear powers have been charged with dumping their nuclear wastes into the Pacific and/or Atlantic Oceans. In addition to this dumping are the radioactive liquid waste discharged by the nuclear powered submarines and warships based and operating in the Pacific and the threat of the USA Navy planning to dump 100 decommissioned nuclear submarines into the Eastern Pacific. The polluting effects of this dumping on human and planetary life has been recognised by the European Peoples as so severe that they have continuously refused permission for it to occur in the European Arena. Now European voices must join in protest with those of the Pacific Peoples being poisoned by a waste they did not create, nor are responsible for.

The next step is Testing of Nuclear Weapons. Although there is a growing European awareness of the French involvement in the Polynesian Islands ( called 'French' Poly--nesia) there is still little known of the activities of theUSA, Britain, China or theUSSR. Since testing was begun in1945 at Hiroshima and Nagasaki by theUSA there have been over 220 tests. An average of 6 each year! This is tantamount to a 38 year old nuclear war! While France continues it's nuclear tests at Moruroa, Polynesia, at a rate of 12 each year and theUSSR and China test fire their missiles into the area theUSA tests both bombs and missiles into the North Pacific mainly at Kwajalein Atoll, in the Marshall Islands, which is also the testing site of the MX missile. The history of USA testing in the Marshall Islands is a study of 66 explosions all much more powerful than the Hiroshima/Nagasaki bombs which have caused the total evaporation of 6 islands and a birth deformity rate of 75%. In the 1950s the British also tested in the Pacific Region, in particular in Central Australia where without warning to the Aboriginal People who were living in that region they conducted 9 nuclear tests. No compensation has yet been given to these people for the sufferings these tests have caused. Everywhere nuclear tests have been made in the Pacific the indigenous peoples have not been consulated or warned and no concern has been given to their well-being. In reality the Pacific Peoples are being used as guinea pigs in a nuclear experimentation. Again this would never be allowed in Europe.

Yet paramount to all of this is the concern that the Pacific is a major site of massive USA depolyment of nuclear systems designed to form a First-Strike Option. Only through the construction of an extensive network of bases, ports, airfields and communication facilitites has the USA been able to progress towards it's First-Strike capability. And nowhere is this network more evident than in the Pacific. Here is based the Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) weapons system and major Command/Control/Communication and Intelligence (C³I) operations for the global strategic plan. As a weapons system is only as effective as it's C³I support and for a First-Strike to be successful the destruction of the opponents ballistic missile submarines is essential these bases have implications which should be of particular concern to Europeans involved in any attempts to overcome the problem of the possibility of First-Strike.

any US launched First-Srike attack. Hawaii basing the largest C'l center in the Pacific and is headquarters of the US Military Command (PACOM) which governs almost one half, 50%, of the Earth's surface is in direct support of the Rapid Deployment Force designed to operate any where in the world but particularly focussed on the Middle East, a possible starting point of a global nuclear war.



# Two Pacific Wimmin Speak



Amoungst the hundreds of similar facilities in the Pacific Regions some of the most vital to USA interests and the most powerful and largest of their kind are located in Australia. These bases which must be in Australia to be effective are directly linked to the First-Strike Strategy. Whilst they have the tasks of Early Warning signals, Post Attack intelligence and the receiving and transmitting of minute-to-minute accurracy data all essential to the co-ordination of any attack or defence one of the main purposes of the Australian C<sup>3</sup>I facilities is to provide communications, including firing signals, with US ballistic missile submarines and in particular with the Trident 2 submarine.based in the Pacific and Indian Oceans.

Submarine Launched Ballistic Missiles (SLBM) have now become an intregal part of the US counterforce strategy because of the advantages they have over Inter-Continental Ballistic Missiles. When one considers the timeflight, flexibility, survivability and mobility of SLBMs and that they carry more than 5,000 of the 9,200 US warheads the for US global strategy of this network begins to take on serious implications.

Of the First-Strike weapons bases in the Pacific and Indian Oceans the important is the Trident 2 Submarine. The Trident2 SLBM is arguably the most deadly weapon system yet devised. Each submarine carrying 408 independently targettable warheads each 5 times more powerful than the Hiroshima bomb with a range of 10,000mls, an accurracy of 25 meters and a 'killing capacity' of 80% has a destructive force greater than Britain, Italy, Spain, Brazil, Argentina, West Germany, Japan, the Philippines, India and Pakistan combined. The Commander of any one Trident submarine is the Third most powerful man after the Presidents of the USA and the USSR. Permission for 14 Tridents has already been granted with the first having entered the Pacific in August 1982 yet the US Navy is pressurring for 16 more.

Other elements of First-Strike based in the Pacific/Indian Oceans are the Trident 1 SLBM fitted to Polaris submarines, Cruise missiles fitted to B52H bomber planes and reconstructed ancient warships carrying 'Tomahawk' Cruise Missiles ( two of these vessels carry more than the total number of Cruise and Pershing 2 missiles being planned for Europe) and the anti-submarine aircraft carriers patrolling the Pacific. These weapons systems are not a speculation of tomorrow...they are there NOW and they are on constant alert!

Removal from the Pacific Region of the US C<sup>3</sup>I facilities and ASW weapons systems would seriously reduce the effectiveness of the US nuclear strategy and the Peoples of the Pacific Region increasingly aware of their critical role towards world-wide disarmament are striving towards this goal and to an end of all aspects of the nuclear cycle and the associated colonialism. Linked through the Pacific Concerns Resource Centre, Hawaii, since 1975 we have seen an increase in Non-Violent Direct Action in the struggle to create and maintain a Nuclear Free and Independent Pacific. As Jim Albertini from Hawaii said: "The issues of a nuclear free, independent and oppression free Pacific are as closely linked as the issues of nuclear weapons and nuclear waste. In truth peace, justice and freedom are one."

Because of the isolation from the activity center of Europe and the media blockading of information it is hard to bridge the support network between European and Pacific Peace Peoples. But both substantial support and a growing awareness of each others problems are very much needed and must be balanced with an understanding of the plight of the Pacific Indigenous Peoples caused by European invasion of their lands. As the message goes:
"IF II'S SAFE..DUMP IT IN TOKYO, TEST IT IN PARIS, STORE IT IN WASHINGTON, BUT...
KEEP MY PACIFIC NUCLEAR FREE..."

Recently (March 29th) two wimmin came to Bristol from the Pacific islands, as part of their ten c city tour of Britain, to raise international awareness of their struggle against nuclear colonia -lism. The whole tour was organ -ised by the wimmyn from Green -ham Common, the peace camp being the inspiration for the event.

On arrival there was much to look at with a large exhibition about the Nuclear presence in the Pacific. There was information on each island, papers & magazines. Also postcards, leafulets & badges for sale as well as vegetarian (not vegan) food.

After an introduction the talk began with Chailang(Rosa Palacios) from Saipan, South Japan. With slides and a large banner which mapped the Racific region she told us the story of Micronesia.

In the 15C. missionaries from Spain invaded the Marshall islands. They took land, raped the women and killed those who would not take Christ. (NOW 97% of the population is Catholic.) The islanders were told to cover their bodies as it was unchris -tian to be naked.

Next, for economic purposes came the Germans. They also took land raped the wimmin and introduced God in the form of the Protest -ant religion.

Now the islanders would fight among themselves over which was the better religion.

Then, there came the Japanese with Buddhism & sugar planta -tions. While they planned to war against the USA the Micro -nesian people became victims having their culture, language and land taken away. Apeople who depended on the land and water to stay alive, they were forced off by the soldiers who wanted their homes to live in. The is -landers were put to work far from home to dig bunkers but were expected to race home in time when the alrm went off.

The Micronesians welcomed the U.S.'peace-keeping' forces after WW2 but soon found they were like any other force.
Using God again they tested the first H bomb on Bikini
Atoll(March 1sT 1954) No-ome on the islands were told


about the bombs being tested.

Six islands evapourated, on others people burned and died while reports by the United Nations said people were just suffering from starvation.

For each woman, she'd have many miscarriages (between 6 -11) If she had children at all they were very badly deformed.

The islanders live as extended families in one house and use the land for growing food. Each family then exchanges food in the clan. Now the Americans buy up the land. The islanders are put to live on Ebeye Island'the slum of the Pacific' while the Americans enjoy & have everything.

The rich American wives have maids (islanders) to work for them -buying food from the military stores, which are cheaper than the other shops. The islanders now stripped of their resources are living below the poverty line but are barred from the cheaper stores. When they demonstrate about the U.S. & Nuclear presence they lose their jobs, and have had their water supply cut off.



The u.s. have built power plants.

Now Japan wants to dump nuclear
waste in the sea. The seas are
polluted already and slowly kill

ing the people with CANCER.

The people who remember WW2 rea
lise the threat of war with the
constant bomb tests.

"If there is another war you
won't have to hide" as a relation
of Chailangs' told her. She has
lost all her family due to cancer
Why has it taken 40 years for
people to realise what is really
going on in the Pacific ?.

Titewhal Harawira from Aotea
-roa(New Zealand) had the same
story again, the invaders being
British missionaries and an armed
force, killing and taking land
and cutting down the population
from 66 million to 2 million. The
1840 Waitangi treaty and all the
other promises made ever since
have never been honoured. The
Maoris refused to fight for the
British in World War 1, but



changed their minds by WW2. The wimmin left behind had to move to the cities to exist-selling the farms they lived on.At the end of the war those men who did did come back had to migrate to the cities also -for work. Maori society is matrilineal and men and women work together. After the missionaries came and colonial laws laid down the men and wimmin were divided. Only the English language could be spoken -the schools teaching the Maori children this, against A their parents wishes.


Did you know that British soldiers were given extra stripes if they captured a Maori chiefs' head(distinguished bybthe tatoos down each side of the head)?

These heads are now seen in museums and collections in Britain. The Maoris want them back.

They want their land back their rights back and the British out. They now number 9 million, 75% being under 25 and 65% are wimmin. They are young and strong and look back in anger at what Great Britain(!) has done. OPPRESSION for the Maoris.150
years of Colonialism, Racism,
Sexism and Christianity.On top
of that they've been used as
8guinea pigs' for testing
bombs.They are not going to
take any more.

For ten years, wymin have a campaigned and have the start for a Nuclear policy in Aotea -roa(40,600, wimmyn at one rall rally) For Titewhai it seemed like only the wimmin were doing anything against the Nuclear threat and urged us to be aware that while we may not want Nuclear bases and bombs in this country, neither did the Pacific want it. In other words, "Destroy yourself by all means but don't take take us with you" "Don't send them back to us".

After the second talk quest
-ions were invited. We were then
informed there wouldn't be much
time for this because the caretaker was impatient to close up
the building (Transport House)
This was very disheartening and
frustrating, especially for the
two speakers. Think about it,



they'd travelled thousands of miles to tell us about their situation, to make contact, to exchange views & ideas with different womens'(& mixed) groups, Then they're told to pack up and go home now - must keep to the rules! I suppose this is what you have to expect from such a corrupt bunch (T.G.W.U.)

Apart from this occurance
the evening went well. Even
though it was a mixed event, more
wimmyn attended, - some from
Greenham. People also came from
Cirencester, Bath, Andover and
Bristol! (not very many though
out of 200)
Something needs to be done





#### 'EMMA GOLDMAN: AN INTIMATE LIFE'by Alice Wexler (Virago)

When I was asked to review this book I was keen to see for myself what all the controversy was all about. I knew that the discovery of letters written to Ben Reitman had been the reason 'to (re-)examine the Goldman legend' but had been led to believe that it was an attack on Goldman's private life or the story of her obsession with pricks".

Well, it's neither of those things.

For those who know nothing about Emma Goldman and her beliefs it's quite a good introduction and for those who do, it fills in many of the background details to 'Living my life' (Goldman's autobiography)

It delves into the myth, 'the demonic legend....an image created partly by a hostile government and sensationalizing press, but one that she herself exploited to popularize her ideas! and shows the "all too human" personality.

It begins with her childhood in Russia. After the assassi -nation of the Tzar in 1881, by the Narodnaya Volya (The Peoples' Will), revolutionary groups were repressed and there were many attacks on the Jews. This situation plus the need to escape from her dominating father led Emma to move to America where she spent most of her life (33yrs.)

After the Haymarket tragedy, she became involved in the Anarchist movement campaigning for "the philosophy of a new social order based on liberty unrestricted by man-made law; the theory that all forms of government rest on violence, and are therefore wrong and harmful, as well as unnecessary"., wimmin's emancipation, sexual freedom, birth control, antimilitarism (opposing the draft in WW1) and for many workers struggles, inc. ding the Industrial Workers of the World (the Wobblies)

Apart from this she spent 12 years producing an Anarchist magazine called'Mother Earth', printed volumes of her essays and went on many lecture tours.

Her unceasing energy, courage and her ability to cope with constant persecution by the Government was a great inspiration to many people including those outside the Anarchist movement.

Wexler studies the 'personality behind the heroic exterior (which) is likely to be a disheartening experience'. She wasn't the great mother figure or tragic herione. Goldman would question her motivation, whether the ideal had dictated the course to take or, was she doing it to work out the "turbulence of my being?". That she wrote down her every mood and feeling is evident by the extracts of the letters she wrote to Reitman. It seems she astounded even herself by such explicitness and passion for "the Great Grand Pas-sion" of her life'.

It is these letters that most people seem to have reacted to because of their erotic intensity which along with Wexler's study has gone some way to reveal the human/personal side of Emma Goldman and break down the image of the heroic mother Earth, often placed on a pedastal for us all to stand in awe of.

Although highly priced at £5.95 it is well worth reading as is Emma Goldman's autobiography''Living my life' 2 vols. (Dover Press) -also highly priced because of the fluctuating dollar!

# THE SCOURGE OF SMOKERS

I think that we live in a pretty sick society, and compared to some of the things that go on, smoking is probably very much of a lesser evil. However, despite the fact that the question of smoking raises some important political issues, and I think some pretty obvious contradictions, it has been largely side stepped or ignored by Anar -chists (and lefties). At a time when smoking is becoming increasing -ly fashionableum in wider society, particularly among the working class, and to an even greater extent among the young, this is not mirrored in Anarchist circles. In Sheffield, at least, the majority of Anarchists seem to smoke. There must be some deep sociological for this, but I am not sure if it is left-over, mis-guided, juvenile 'behind the bike sheds' rebelliousness, plain trendyism, or what. However I think it does show up a gap in political consciousness at a time when we are increasingly thinking about things like authority roles, covert sexual harrassment, dominance within rela -tionships, etc. the fairly obvious one-sided oppressive relation -ship between smokers and non-smokers is ignored. Even the supposed 7ly considerate attitude of some smokers is transparently false. When smokers lay their fags on the table and say "Is it alright if I smoke?" they are really saying "Am I going to get my way, or are you determined enough to kick up a fuss and cause an unplea -sent scene?" . Surely there are parities between this and some forms of rape.

The third world is starving to feed your habit. Good land, badly needed to grow crops is squandered in order to provide your fags. Last year Ethiopia produced 1,375,000,000 cigarettes.

Smokers pollute the air, and are walking refuse-tips. At the Anarchist Centre the smokers there "never" dropped their fag butts on the floor for other people to sweep up, yet the floor, and every -thing else, was always covered with fag-ends, cigarette ash and dead matches-and somebody dropped them.

The accidents caused by smokers are considerable, every year people die and are injured in fires caused by smokers.

Anarchista have a higher chance than most people of being imprisoned, and in prison your tabacco addiction will be used as a punishment and a way of controlling you. Prison is not a good place to stop smoking, so why not stop now, before your habit comp-romises you further?

What about the testing of the effects of smoking on animals in vivisection laboratories? Changing brands or smoking roll-ups simply side-steps the issue. Animals are being tortured, not only for 'quality control', but in order to try and find cures for cancer ridden smokers. Vegans who spend their time tirelessly searching the backs of crisps and biscuits packets for the offensive 'E's' con-veniently ignore the fact that the gum on their Rizla papers\* is made from boiled animal bones.

The society of the spectacle tries to con us into believing we need so many useless commodities to make us happy.T.V.'s, fast cars, fashionable clothes, etc. all are used as trinkets to buy us off. They try to convince us we need this junk to be happy, in order that we will devote our lives to a never-ending quest for the next great 'commodity'. 'Bread and Circuses' on a grand scale, and they laugh all the way to the bank. Few commodities are pushed as much as (or can be as useless as) cigarettes, and smokershave fallen hook, line and sinker for the image the tobbacco ads feed us.

By smoking in public places, smokers not only aid the advertisers in selling smoking to another generation of nicotine addicts, but they also pass on their ill health to everyone else. It's bad enough not being able to go upstairs on a bus without coughing your guts up, but when Anarchists cannot be more considerate there

is something seriously wrong. The risks to the health of nonsmokers caused by smokers are considerable, not to mention the sheer
unpleasentness of being drowneddin smoke. Every week after the
Sheffield Anarchists meeting, I come home smelling like an ashtray
and when I smell my clothes the next day, I nearly heave so badly
that I have no choice, but to change them. If the choice is either
to put up with this or not attend meetings, then they aren't
Anarchist meetings.


Even those too young to object have to put up with the selfish and oppressive ways of the tabbacco tyrants. Before the recent National Anarchist conference in Sheffield we discussed the issue of smoking. We decided that we would ask smokers to sit to the right of the room. We were meeting in. A notice was put on the door asking smokers to do this, and card signs saying "No smoking please" were placed on the tables to the left of the room. I came to the conference with a 5 week old baby, and sat at one of the no smoking tables. Within minutes 2 people sat directly on either side of her (the baby) and lit up. I moved, and put the baby's pram in the corner of the room. 5 minutes later she was joined by yet another group of inconsiderate smokers. It is a wonder that her health is not already irreparably damaged, as before she was born, smoking Anarchists were just as inconsiderate with her pregnant mother.

It has taken me alot of time to finally get to writing an article about the tyranny of tobbacco, although I doubt if my words will have any great effect, these things have to be said. Smoking is real oppression - here and now, and if you choose to ignore it then you're a bloody poor Anarchist.

Footnote; I would like to make it clear that there are one or two smoking Anarchists who I have found to be genuinely considerate and who take responsibility for their habit to a large extent. I have also noticed that since I told people that I had written an article about smoking, there has been an increase in the amount of consideration being shown by some smokers, I hope that this trend continues. It's just a shame that these things have to be said first, before smokers stop and think about their selfish ways.
