

READ THIS THE HAZARDS OF VOTING FOR EVERYONE!

The Conservatives.

- 1. Will the Conservatives continue with the Beeching Plan?
- 2. If you have lots of money and want a house (or a call girl?) conservative freedom works, but if you are in the lower income group and can't afford to wait for years to get a council flat, or if you are unable to pay high interest rates on loans what are the Tories going to do for you?
- 3. Will the Conservatives continue to allow the rich to get richer? We've had a pay pause What about a profits pause?
- 4. When nothing was to be gained by the further testing of Nuclear Bombs, the Conservatives signed the test ban treaty. A Nuclear War would be the war to end war and society. Will the Tories ban the bomb as well as nuclear tests?
- 5. Will the Conservatives use the organisation of the Regional Seats of Government to break any widespread strike action such as they planned to do during the 1926 General Strike?
- 6. Do the Conservatives intend to continue the breeding of germs at the Microbiological Research Establishment at Porton (Germ Warfare Centre)?

- 1. How often will the Labour Government bring out troops against Strikers as they did in: October/November 1945 (London Docks), July 1946 (Southampton Docks), May 1949 (Avonmouth Docks), September 1950 (Smithfield Lorry Drivers, Power and Gas Workers)?
- 2. How soon would Labour M.P.s vote themselves salary increases?
- 3. Would workers have a say in the management of nationalised industries?
- 4. Would Labour legislate against unofficial strikes?
- 5. Would Labour reintroduce conscription?
- 6. Will the Labour Party reject absolutely the Beeching Plan
- 7. Would a Labour Government do away with the Regional Seats of Government, or would it just change the personnel?
- 8. Would a Labour Government use the R.S.G.'s to break any widespread strike action?
- 9. If elected, does Labour intend to continue the use of the Germ Warfare Centre at Porton?
- 10. Would a Labour Government repeal the Official Secrets Act? Or would it, as a socialist party, keep its secrets from the people?

The Liberal Party.

- 1. Mr. Grimond has said in his recent book that it might be necessary to re-introduce conscription. Would the Liberals do this if they were in power?
- 2. Would the Liberals close down the Germ Warfare Centre at Porton? If not, why not?

The Communist Party (League of Russian Empire Loyalists)

- 1. Why do Communists condemn all nuclear tests except Russian ones? Does radiation from the "workers' bomb" smell sweeter? Or do their party cards protect them?
- 2. Does the candidate support Khruschev or Mao Tse Tung? In either case, why?
- 3. Would a Communist Government be in favour of workers' control in industry, or would industry be run by State bureaucrats as in Russia?
- 4. Would a Communist Government keep the Germ Warfare Centre at Porton in existence?
- 5. If elected, would a communist government stay in NATO or join the Warsaw Pact?

THE QUESTIONS in this leaflet are designed to make you think again before you vote, no matter for what party.

Certain minority parties, both left and right, have been excluded but only for limitations of space. We maintain that the same
basic criticism of the 4 parties dealt with here applies to ALL
parties and politicians - everywhere! Their interests are too
far removed from our interests. An M.P. isn't really as important
as he might try to make out.

We as anarchists believe that going to vote for a party or an individual is merely wishful thinking. The only Parliament you can trust is the one made up of people you personally know! If you want a better life the only positive way to achieve it is by accepting more responsibility and taking greater interest in local affairs and matters that concern YOU. Don't wait for your M.P. to help you over housing, form Tenants' Associations with the people round you. If you have trouble with the Boss don't wait for the union bureaucrats to come rushing to set the management, take direct action and organise your strike or work to rule on the spot!

IF you feel that you should do something on polling day and not merely abstain from voting don't vote for a candidate, mark your card:-
