THE BRITISH NATIONAL PARTY must've thought they were pretty lucky getting Derek 'Alf Garnett' Beackon elected in Millwall last 16th September. The NF got two councillors elected back in the 1970s but the NF's now so feeble C18 can beat up its fuhrer, Ian Anderson, and so bent Anderson can rip off party funds to pay his mortgage with the full approval of the rest of his executive!

The BNP know now a single councillor means fuck all except publicity. It bought in a couple of hundred members - but also got the anti-fascist's act together.

As Beackon walked into office, council workers walked out. Not known as a genius, he then made prattish comments about deportation that could disbar him and he's now in hiding.

The BNP Brick Lane papersale was driven off after anti-fascists rallied there three weekends in a row, C18 lost face to a sly kicking from Youth against Racism in Europe, the local Asian community organised itself and the cops kept far-Right East End support out the second weekend.

Richard Edmonds, deputy BNP fuhrer, also got himself banged up for some dumb glassing incident, leaving his missus all alone at the Welling bunker. There's a lifelong GA sub due whoever tells us where he's remanded...

We still need the Big One. Greenwich Council are still being total tossers about shutting the BNP Bunker despite its clear dual use and major demos, two ending in

On the events of 16th October, we'll draw a veil over the ARA v. ANL bickering - careerist bullshit the Lawrences were right to wash their hands of.

We also don't really give a damn whether 25,000 (cops) or 45,000 (ANL) turned out for it, if all they were going to do was march. We see no reason to dispute claims that the Met sealed off all routes of march when it arrived at Upper Wickham Lane and therefore started trouble - except to say it was better people arrived ready for trouble that the cops pushing it on them. They were well tooled up for it and were into beating on people, punishing them for turning up, rather than nicking them. As with Trafalgar Square, the Scum can do that job for them later ...

What we do say as our bottom line is that HUGE numbers of people fought to get through THOUSANDS of riot cops for FOUR hours just to get their hands on the fascists. The BNP should shit themselves. Think what would have happened if the marchers HAD got their hands on a nazi! C18 say "Let them hate so long as they fear" -- about time the fascists started FEARING our HATE!

COLNE

ON APRIL 16th, AFA descended upon Colne, described by the BNP as the "last White town in Lancashire" (though the large crew of Asian youth who turned out obviously didn't realise this). Having convinced themselves of their own popularity the BNP stood a candidate in a council by-election, choosing racist jailbird Shaun Cranbie to carry the flag.

The fascist's plans for an election rally on the 16th came badly a cropper when AFA were told the location of the venue by disgrunted locals and took up residence in and around Ball Grove Community Centre in advance of the fash. The BNP's triumphal entry into Ball Grove involved about 40 patriotic losers skulking in a corner of the park greeted by an 80 strong AFA with cries of "sieg heil" for the benefit of the police who thought we were the BNP despite the presence of Black and Asian activists! Unfortunately the fascists knew who we were and retreated as we charged at them, being saved by riot police and dog handlers.

With the fascists cringing behind police lines, our attention turned to a carload of latecomers behind AFA lines. They were immediately set upon by about 25 anti-fascists who trashed their car and rearranged their faces while their aryan brothers looked on. Three antifascists were arrested and now face serious public order charges. -----

BURNLEY

ANTI-FASCIST ACTION again had reason to visit the town of Burnley on 25th September in response to BNP activity. They were standing two candidates in local elections, one of whom was gormless twat Scott O'Sullivan.

The ANL had arrived before us and gone round accusing everyone they didn't like the look of of being nazis (including two Black fans I talked to!), which hadn't endeared locals to the anti-fascist presence. The fash from Burnley had also whipped up many fans into a frenzy over 'reds' coming to Burnley looking for a scrap.

This made the day a fiasco, alternating between being penned in and confronting Burnley fans while the BNP, including Ken Henderson and Richard Edmonds, never came into town at all. These shitheads and sixty of their genetically impaired followers were escorted around the nearby town of Bacup by the cops who allowed them to leaflet a council estate!

With hindsight, things don't look too bad. The BNP got so few votes that they've abandoned Burnley altogether, AFA recieved an OK write-up in the local press, Burnley Trades Council have stated they'll financially support AFA activists arrested on the day and local Asian youth are talking about forming an AFA group. So all's well that ends well.



TWYFORD IS DOWN AND OUT but it's set the new pattern for road resistance.

ON THE DOWN

When the Cats started excavating on 22nd February, they faced three Dongas from the short-lived Plague Pits camp - mot of Earth First! were at a lame duck demo at the other end of the country.

A hard core set about daily disruption from Camelot Camp at Olivers Battery, at the south side of the Itchen Valley, but the toll of arrestees mounted. Most of these actions were 'Group 4dodging to lock on the Cat'-type stuff, but some were different - the occupation of local contractors offices, including Tarmac's at Chandlers Ford on 19th March thast got their file store flooded, computers wiped and 30 of us arrested.

Most turned out for irregular weekend Days of Action which got stroppier as days went on. By April 17th, the Cats were being covertly wrenched after we'd locked onto them, one being put out for a fortnight after its hydraulics were fractured. That day there was also a fuss about four Group 4 guys being done over -BS, unfortunately.

The next Day of Action around the end of April saw 'daylight monkeywrenching' - people splitting into 40strong mobile mobs to devastate any unprotected plant and then driving off in convoy. A cool £20,000 in five minutes with no busts! There was 'night maintainence' too by this time, ELF sneaking on site to weaken plant hydraulics.

This all peaked with the Battle of the Bailey Bridge on 22nd-23rd May the DoT had to get a bridge in place on the one day the A33 was closed. Against this Operation Market Garden, EF!ers came up with Operation Greenfly, barrelling through razor wire and cops and Group 4 that outnumbered them three-to-one to stop the bridge being moved. The lock-on was

reprieved by local officials fearing "another Twyford Down" on their doorsteps.

THE INJUNCTION

A dubious collaboration between Hampshire Constabulary, Group 4 and Brays Detective Agency got the names of key activists together by June. If some were absurd ('Reed Warbler', 'Miss Raspberry' etc), that didn't stop the DoT applying for an injunction to stop activists trespassing and trashing their works. A High Court judge, Justice Alliot, not only granted the injunction (absurdities and all) but made all on it "jointly and severally liable" for

The injunction was obvious bollocks and Alliot a pawn of the road lobby so on the 4th July Twyford Requim demo, around 20 of the 55 injunctees joined a mass trespass the length of the Tory Canyon through the Down. One immediate effect of this defiance was the scrapping of the planned road throgh Oxleas Wood [see GA31], worth a hundred

times that through the Down to the DoT! This led to Brays chasing 13 they'd videoed and on 23rd July, eight of them played the game enough to appear in

de Meana, the EC official who resigned over Twyford. All very embarrassing for the DoT, not least when the activists made a big thing out of how UK had bent EC rules to trash the Down upon their release.

Alliot copntinued chasing those that refused to surrender to his court when Mike Hamblett did after a TV appeal, he got off on the defence Rogers used. Of course, to date, all injunctees have the DoTs £2 million claim for damages hanging over them...

THE STRUGGLE CONTINUES

With most key activists barred from the Down, the struggle broadened. On the Twyford front, Wolverhampton EF! repeatedly led activists through Tarmac's national HQ, disrupting their AGM on 15th June and siezing files ALIU-style on 23rd August as "Earth police".

After their release, Pail Pritchard and Bob Baehr headed north to join the Flowerpot Tribe's struggle against Newcastle City Council's destruction of Jesmond Dene, urban greenspace, for a crap road allegedly to save "30 seconds" through the town! As at Twyford, injunctions were dished out and private security were called in, but as the result of a hell of a lot of tree-sitting and spiking and occupations of plant and concrete casts in August, the Council have been forced to "consider" their scheme.

The DoT's Oxleas flop set the stage for the other big struggle at the moment - the M11 was supposed to be the north end of the East London River Crossing. It will also mea\n the bulldozing of 350 houses and more trees by contractors NorWest Holst. Since 14th September, Dongas and Green Man EF! have been occupying both in a cat-andmouse game with Group 4, out to enforce possession on their squats and keep them out of other buildings and trees.

Post-Twyford experience has spawned many other local campaigns - it's vital that the movement is strengthened by this and not dispersed!


BIG BROTHER?

THIS IS A STORY of infiltration (spying), disinformation (lying), and double dealing. We'll introduce the characters as we go along.

Tim Hepple started his association with Green Anarchist early in 1991. Before this he had been involved with the Quakers, anti-poll tax movement and anti-Gulf War campaign in Lancaster. He attended the Green Party conference in Bridlington and the Wolverhampton conference later that year.

He never hid his fascist 'past' and was an enthusiastic, if sometimes 'imaginative', activist but we should have taken his boasts to ourselves and others that he had worked for MI5 and been mixed up in an army assassination squad in Northern Ireland more seriously.

During the course of his involve -ment with GA introduced a friend of his, Ray Hill, who very conveniently lived just round the corner from Tim Hepple and ran the village shop in Caton. Ray Hill was the same Ray Hill who had once been a fascist mole and who has a regular column written under his name in Searchlight, the antifascist magazine. At this stage we were naive enough to believe in the positive credentials of Search-

Ray Hill wrote an article in the Autumn 1991 issue of Green Anarchist titled Creating A Community [GA28, pp. 14-15] which advocated that people donate £1,000 each to get together and buy a Scottish island and set up a self-sufficient rural community. At the time it looked fair enough. Looking back we see how Hepple and Hill reinforced each other's credibility on initially making contact with GA.

Understandable so far, isn't it? OK. Tim Hepple made contact with GA in Oxford during August 1991 claiming he wanted to set up a north west anarchist network. He asked to see GA's address list. The point about this is that GA is not an open organization, and quite a lot of nasty people would like to know the names of people who are crazy enough to subscribe to such an extreme publication.

Some time after this, using his banner unfurling stunt at the Wolverhampton Green Party confer -ence as a springboard, Tim Hepple also became involved with the setting up of Green Revolution, and was trying to get hold of the address list belonging to

Are you keeping up with this? Let's change the scene a little. Just put Tim Hepple to the back of your mind and think about Combat 18. Combat 18 stands for 'Combat Group Adolf Hitler' - 'A' for Adolf being the first letter of the alphabet, 'H' the eighth. C18 is a fascist paramilitary organizat-

It publishes lists of antifascists; names, addresses and telephone numbers of Left wing activists in Redwatch. Target, an associated magazine produced by Pro-Fascist Action publishes the same sort of information.

Some of this information was then used to target individuals, and Combat 18 also carried out attacks on the Morning Star and Freedom Press.

Once knowledge of the existence of these lists spread through into the Left, Tim Hepple appeared with the obvious answer - a Leftproduced list of fascists. After all, whto would be better placed to do this than the mole who had worked in the BNP bookshop just a few months before? So Tim Hepple passed a list of fascists to Green Anarchist, together with some interesting information about just who was responsible for Redwatch and Target.

Unknown to Tim Hepple, the editors of Green Anarchist had been contacted by Larry O'Hara, the independent anti-fascist

shop in Welling he heard from fasc -ist sources that Tim Scargill, who was then in the process of splitting from the Class War Federation, was a 'turncoat' supplying C18 information on the Left for their hit lists via Croydon BNP.

A month or so after Hepple tried to put this story about in anarchist circles via GA, Scargill published a list of fascist names identical to the one Hepple had given to us, together with the disinformation about Combat 18, in a Class War Organisation internal

bulletin called Network News. Hepple had boasted that he's "dropped Scargill right in it". We were to find out why, and something of the slimey way in which Searchlight operates, when the April 1993 and subsequent issues of Searchlight attacked Scargill for circulating the very list which Hepple, a Searchlight pawn, had planted in the anarchist movement.

The story doesn't end there. The Targetters Targetted list started out by saying "The BNP have published the membership lists of Class War and Red Action in a magazine called Target". Hepple tried to pass the list off on GA before November 1992 and stuff about CW and Red Action only appeared in the second issue of Target, published in February 1993. How come Hepple knew what was in Target 2 a good three months before its publication? Ask yournotes and chronologies he'd bunged Searchlight to ghost-write into 'coherent' form for publication.

The attacks on Tim Scargill, Larry O'Hara and, after the publication of A Lie Too Far, on Green Anarchist itself in the pages of Search -light only serve to confirm our view of what has happened.

If the facts and interpretations in A Lie Too Far are incorrect and they include the reproduction of a letter to GA's editor by Hepple in his own handwriting that "Tim Scargill, Larry O'Hara and co are the victims of a vicious smear campaign" - detailed exposition would expose this. In fact the opposite seems to be the case, with Gable himself conceding in At War With Society that Hepple was responsible for the lists being passed to Scargill! Frenzied personal attacks on A Lie Too Far's authors and publishers are beside the point. Is it true or isn't it?

If somebody like Tim Hepple can infiltrate the far Right, pretending to be a fascist and walking off with their address list, is it so far-fetched to believe that the same person could do the same thing to the Left?

If this is true, then what does that make his employer?

(3) the Hepple letters reproduced in ALTF being genuine (passim)

-- Gable's only comment is to say I have seen one letter to GA from Hepple (AWWS, p. 34). In fact I've seen quite a few. If even one is genuine, then they all must be, as they are indisputably in the same hand.

(4) that Hepple passed dummy lists to GA, eventually printed by Scargill (ALTF, pp. 23-29)

-- Gable actually admits "names and addresses he [ie. Hepple] hand -ed over to green anarchists were used in hit lists circulated by nazi infiltrators like Tim Scargill" (p.

-- Dont forget Searchlight's assert -ion that the lists were "deliberately false" (April 1993, p. 14) and "a smokescreen for the continuing activities of the criminals of C18" (March 1993, p. 24)

(5) highly suspicious foreknowledge by Searchlight concerning the contents of Target 2, combined with a refusal to admit its existence or that it targeted Scargill (ALTF, pp. 25-6)

-- the only public reference to Target 2 is in a 17/3/93 Reigate Independant story - not written by a Searchlight asset (ALTF, p. 32)

-- thus, this disturbing possibity of Searchlight collusion with fascists in some aspects of targeting (especially anarchists) is still unrefuted - very interesting.

(6) that Searchlight allegations that Tim Scargill is a Nazi collaborator are fiction (ALTF, pp. 29-32/46-49)

-- April 1993's Searchlight stated he "dodged facing" AFA members (p. 14). Now AWWS lamely states he had been "playing political foot -sie with anti-fascist activists" (p.

-- In AWWS, Hepple writes (p.

"The story from Croydon BNP, related to me on three separate occassions by Ballard, Woods and Merritt respectively, is that Scargill meets them regularly and that they are in close contact still, after all these years. I once mentioned Class War at the BNP shop during a visit from Merritt to pick up some propaganda material. "Yeah, we know all about that, we know Tim Scargill, you know, he's really into this working class

Hepple is supposed to be a credible witness but Merritt's quote hardly implies Scargill is a Nazi and in his 7/2/93 letter to GA's editor, Hepple wrote (p. 2):

"I got the impression that Merrick [sic] knew a lot more about Scargill and I deliberately mentioned Class War on a number of occassions to elicit further information. Merrick would always say, "Oh yeah, we know him" - but not as a threat. Wot's Goin On Here?"

The lack of consistency between the two accounts casts doubt on both - if Hepple is so cavalier in his re-writing of what he heard concerning Scargill, how seriously can we take quotes he attributes to others?

(7) That continued assertions by Searchlight that I am "a Nazi errand boy" are baseless

-- I have interviewed some far Right people for my PhD/book so I am in a far better position than any previous Left critic to come to an independant, factually based assessment of the fascist scene. Searchlight seek to use my very strength - use of primary sources - to drag my name down into the mud alongside theirs.

-- A baseless lie - should anyone (from Left field!) care to pay costs, I'll be happy to take legal

-- There is evidence for incessant lies in Searchlight and now AWWS' connecting me spuriously with Nazis, the IRA &c to incite violence against me. I predict Gable's next step will be printing my home address, something I have never done to Searchlight assets despite the utmost provocation.

green anarchists that we understood how Hepple exposed himself by contacting [them]" (AWWS, p. 34). The fact is that he had been exposed as early as September 1992 in issue 3 of Thor-Would, where it is stated "agent provocateur Tim Hepple is surfacing again, Tim ... should be avoided at all costs" Who is this prescient editor? Steve Sergeant, younger brother of Charlie, someone running C18 according to Searchlight! All this contradicts Searchlight's fiction that I learnt of Hepple via his letters to Green Anarchist, items I only saw for the first time in March 1993.

-- As to how the far Right finally tumbled Hepple, well, he must thank himself for that. According to Alan Milnes, writing in the first post-Hepple White Resistance (issue 7, May 1993, p. 2) "when late last year he presented me with leaflets supposedly printed by the Anti-Nazi League at Lancaster University denouncing Hepple and calling for his lectures to be picketed, suspicions were turned to certainties: the leaflets were badly forged on a simple word processor! From that point on, contact with Hepple was severed".

(9) That I threatened Hepple/his family after the WIA programme (AWWS, p. 34)

(10) The disgraceful slurs against the Green Anarchist collective

-- Having failed to entrap them earlier, Gable now describes ALTF, which they co-produced, as an item eminating from "nazi counter -intelligence" (p. 18)

-- The idea that Searchlight is "run by Zionists" is attributed to green anarchists (and nazis). But as Tony Greenstein remarked in his 16/7/93 letter to Gable "I have always found if difficult to oppose racism or fascism in Britain and then turn a blind eye to racism and fascism directed against Palestinians simply because the perpetrators are Jewish. You have no such qualms" (p. 2). Saying Search -light is Zionist is nothing to do with Nazi 'code' for 'world conspiracy' - it's the correct designation for a supporter of the state of Israel.

-- Readers will be intrigued to hear GA is a "hunting ground for fascists and nazis" (p. 34), especially when they split from former editor Richard Hunt in early 1992 because of his support for militarism and patriarchy. Perhaps Search -light were merely referring to GA allowing Hill and Hepple to write for them?














REVOLUTION ON THE PERPHER

GA's editor outlines general strategy

terms of war and the enemy is civilization, the system that puts We're near civilization's core one above another and gives those on top the power to objectify and exploit everyone else. Time's running out for this shit system, but we've got to destroy it before it destroys everyone else with it. It's not a question of when do we fight but how.

We'll take 'by any means necessary' as a start, but why make things hard on yourself? Civilisation's about concentration, all the wealth and power in the hands of a few. You can wait around for -ever until you're strong enough to tackle them head-on, but that's not the green anarchist way.

We argue for the revolution on the periphery, and that's pretty much anywhere the heirarchs power is weak, not strong. Hit 'em where they're weak and you can win now or in the near future. Hit them enough times like that and in the end they'll dwindle away to nothing. Maoists call this 'the war of a thousand fleas'.

When we say "hit 'em", I mean anyhow - physically, economically, ideologically, culturally, you name it. Armed struggle alone won't smash civilization - transferring a monopoly of arms from one elite to another will preserve it instead. Imagination and ideas are more important weapons in our arsenal and that's why they're so tightly controlled/stifled by the existing

You'll never change society from within - the more you can get out of it, the more you can create an alternative to it. The strategy we're talking here is the means to that alternative - breaking down mass control, centralised power - and the people that are going to build the alternatives are the ones most exploited and with

the lowest respect in/for so-called

here in UK, the belly of the beast, so we should start looking at 'the strategy of the soluble'. Do what you want openly when the State allows it, call it something else or do it secretly if the State doesn't, and attack It at it's weakest only if that doesn't work. We'll be amazed what you can get away with.

In terms of 'nuts and bolts', we're looking at cultural change -'culture of resistance' - not one anti-civ milleau but many, all the different countercultures shat on by society, all with their own values and united only piecemeal as common oppressions arise. If it's fun, gives people the meaning and respect they don't get in 'rat race' society, others'll join in and

People can't eat fun, of course. Parrallel economic activity is important - the green and black economy - tackle the loopholes and blindspots to make your living and tie it into the alternative network not State societies. Support each other economically as well as socially.

Is the State going to stand for this? No chance - it only holds power because there's no alternative to it, because it does what we can rightly do for ourselves (eg. education, healthcare, housing &c). It's going to start closing the loopholes what little imagination it's left us have opened. The crackdown on raves and festies is an example of this at work. We can keep playing the 'soluble strategy' and in the end we'll win because civilisation's on a deadend course, but the top heirarchs in their self-contained bunkers will be the last to go, as any look at emergency planning or that Biosphere 2 shows.

What we need is dual level organisation, an alternative underground, the 'fish' in the 'sea' of the culture of resistance. The pigs aren't welcome in the latter so there's no way they'll penetrate the former if there's even basic understanding of security. As to the offensive, people with no stake in the system can attack it without restraint - they re not cutting their own throats. Scattered, spont -aneously acting cells can cause chaos if they know what they're doing. Due to division of labour, civilisation is a highly vulnerable, mutually-interdependant network bound together by infrastructural threads that anyone with the basic know how can cut.

However, I'd counsel restraint here as you never really know when the last push is needed. Always use the minimum necessary force to achieve your ends - so you can use your remaining energies elsewhere, don't provoke a back-lash and keep 'em guessing as to what you really are capable of in extremis. The latter should stay the State's hand until it's too late for it to strike. I'm not saying "be reactive" - I am saying your actions should be dictated by the broader aclternative agenda and a 'don't tread on me' principle of community defence.

Finally, words of warning. Tearing down the existing order is no good thing if you replace it. Bigger isn't better - never organise on principles of mass. If a group's getting too big for everyone to have their say, respect diversity and split it so everyone gets to do what they do best. If one group in a network is developing monopoly, get them to teach what they know to everyone else or share their



Our anonymous surrealist advocates an end to consumerism

ONCE THERE WAS THE ALF Mars Bar hoax. Then Lucozade. Now there are 'counterfeit' goods, pirate products made to look like established brands, fake Reebok trainers, or Coke tins not licenced by the Coca-Colonial Company. Earlier this year they had a scare when fake washing powder made of caustic soda went into the supermarket shelves, boxed like a well known brand but really mixed up by criminals in a disused Ashton Under Lyne warerhouse, and packed into fire 'damaged' carton stock.

In Central Lancashire some blackmailers were caught attempting to threaten a butcher's chain with maggots in the meat. We have dangerous toys, caustic soda washing powder - the consumer nightmare is a place where the seemingly harmless is lethal.

TO BE OR NOT TO BE PARAMOID

Annette writes from Holloway about State survaillence

RICHARD AND I have just sat through our four week trial, and I hope to pass onto everyone some of the information we have come across. This is not intended to be a scare story, but to help us better understand the way the police treat Animal Rights.

If you asked a person on the street "what do you think the police spend their budgets on", most would say that the biggest expense was the IRA and morder cases. Few would guess that in some parts of the country the next area is Animal Rights! However there is a special unit working out of Scotland Yard, called the Animal Rights National Index (ARNI). Their task is to gather large amounts of information on individuals. When, during our trial, it became clear that they were doing a much better job of it than we had ever imagined, I decided to try and establish their sources of information and how they use it.

So far the police have indexes on piople, addresses, vehicles and telephone numbers. it is quite shocking to find they have 21,000 names on the Index. Each persons sheet runs like this. Name, address, d.o.b., schooling, job, phone number, other numbers such as passport and bank accounts, aliases used, physical descriptions with updates if it changes ie. baircuts, contact with police, sightings on demos or hunts, people standing next to the subject or travelling together, vehicles registered to subject and vehicles driven, associates and friends, memberships of organisations and past record of convictions.

Obviously, the more contact the police have had with you the larger the file. But the more active you are, for instance BE CAREFUL!

sabbing, demos and friends involved in campaigning, the more likely is the chance of them having something on your file. They use this information to

build up an idea of who knows who and how strong their involvement is. So the areas we should be keenly aware of being careful about are address books and vehicles. Perhaps go through your address book and rewrite without using surnames and area (s.t.d.) codes. That will confuse them if they ever get their hands on it! If you can, use hired vehicles on demos and register your car at a different address, or better still all use the same address. Another area to be caereful

about is the type of literature you kiip in your house. An SG Newsletter may be perfectly innocent in your house, but if the prosecution holds it up in court it takes on a completely different perspective. During our court case they used household items plastic bottles, sellotape, candles to try and say they could be used to make incenduary devices. It shows you how single minded they can be, not to see the innocence of these things. Be wary of new people asking stupid questions, and be aware that whenever you join an organisation the police know about it, from BUAV to ALFSG. Another area is telephones, houses and cars - treat them as bugged.

I sincerely hope that this helps people to build up a healthy paranoia. I am not intending to scaremonger people into stopping going to demos or any other activities, but I hope this gives us a better understanding of how intensely the policae are acting out their Big Brother role. And I pass the message on to everyone -

VIOLENCE?

A discussuion paper from the **Band Of Mercy**

THE ISSUE OF VIOLENCE and the endangerment of human 'physical wellbeing! has recently returned to the deebating tables of the animal liberation movement. This has come about because of the revival of the Animal Rights Militia (ARM).

The Spring 1993 issue of the Animal Liberation Front Supporters Group newsletter informs us of two recent ARM actions. Firstly, the now infamous Christmas contamination action taken against various Boots stores in the South of England; And secondly the planting of an "intricate explosive device" within Birmingham University in late February.

The reaction of the movement, so far, in general, has been one of open condemnation. Especially as the ARM's policy seems to of changed since its rebirth and they now, besides targetting individual animal abusers, are also targeting those who support animal abusers financially. One would assume that the logic behind such a policy change is that the animal abuse supporters are guilty of animal cruelty by association. In the same way a person who buys and wears a fur coat os guilty of association with those who killed the animals in the first place, a person who shops in Boots is guilty of associat -ion with those who vivisect at Boots. In both cases the associate is providing the financial means for the continuation of animal

The justification behind the use

of ARM type tactics is that in the short tearm the endangerment of physical welbeing obtains results. In 1986, in Australia, the 'Brisbane ARM' managed to have millions of pounds worth of meat destroyed after they claimed a major contamination action, against the meat industry. The contaminant in this action was claimed to be rat

showed (as other similar actions have shown) there was a public outcry with condemnation coming from all quarters. Yet despite this condemnation, these actions, that risk harm to human well being, continue. In America, in November 1988, Fran Trutt was arrested for carrying a remote control for detonating some explosives which had been placed next to a United Surgical Corporation building. More explosives and two weapons were later found in Fran's New York apartment and she was sentenced for attempted murder. Many people, following Fran's sentence, thought that that would be an end to the issue of violence. Yet it wasn't.

In 1990, in England, two car bombs exploded under the vehicles of the vivisectors Margaret Basker -ville and Patrick Headley. Neither of these vivisectors were hurt, but in the Patrick Headley incident, a young child was injured by flying shrapnel. Again these actions received wide condemnation from both outside and within the movement. The hostile feelings

Well one could guaranteed. thos less campaigners theorise that overall the movement would be 'out on the street' and new recruits would be hard to find and an overall smallir movement would emerge.

The third agnd final scenario that this discussion paper shall be looking at is that of the possible results of pirforming an armed hijack. We can take it as read that there would be a wide spread condemnation of the action, but besides that, the short term effects would be the companies having their insurance policies go up and they would be forced into employing extra security guards to ensure tshe safe passage of their vehicles. Thos an armed hijack would appear to be a good form of economic sabotage (drivers may also cease to work for an animal abuse company, fearing for their physical well being). But in a prolonged campaign of this sort, the authorities would very quickly tset up the use of decoy lorries containing armed marksmen/ women. Already we have seen a situation where one member of the Whickham Four, at the htime. of their arrest, had a rifle placed to their head. And very recently, when an alleged ALF activist was arrested in Northern Ireland, the arrest was performed by eight

armed RUC officers. So it is not inconceivable that such strong arm tactics will be used again and surely it must.

But to the scenario. Once the decoy lorry had been intercepted by the hijackers the authorities would have no hesitation in shoot -ing the activists DEAD! The SAS has already shot a number of suspected IRA members dead, in similar decoy manoeuvres, so we could expect the same thing to happen to animal liberation activists. If animal liberation activists were shot, there might be a public outcry with some opposition MPs calling for a public inquiry into the shooting (as has happened whenever the SAS have shot IRA members) but the over all result is the same; Dedicated activists would be dead.

So, as this discussion paper has shown, the use of violence can, we feel, only lead to a recruitment problem: a smaller animal liberation movement; longer prison sentences; a Government clampdown on the animal liberation movement; And even the possibility of dead activists.

IS THAT REALLY GOING TO HELP THE ANIMALS?

THE AUTHOR of the discussion paper above claims to speak for the Band of Mercy. If so, it's the 1990 version whose formation parodied the Lee/Goodman original by refusing the tactic of arson and whose claims of activity are so unsubstantiated that the ALF Supporters Group regard them with

The author seems totally out of touch - after the last season, many sabs have already used violence in self-defence against hunt heavies as a matter of survival. not choice. We're talking wellobvious facts of life here, not ivory tower "scenarios".

What s/he writes of as future possibility is already present-day reality. Activists Mike Hill and Tom Whorby are dead, animal liber -ationists are already subject to intense survaillence from ARNI. media blackouts alternate with disinformation campaigns and then there's the mass round-ups, conspiracy busts, punitive sentencing and frame-ups. So does that mean there's no disincentive to animal liberationist violence now?

The State has resorted to these measures not because the ALF is violent but because it is effective. It's effective not because of "the image of a burnt out car on the front of all the newspapers" but the reality of targets destroyed. Direct action is not an appeal to others but an end-in-itself. We don't need their intervention because we're sorting out what bugs us directly, ourselves. Unlike lobbyist groups, we believe we have that power - we don't surrender it to politicians. That way lies a future society free of them, one where we are self-determining individuals.

The discussion paper's been widely circulated to the animal lib press, the author presuming s/he can evade critical discussion because of the ALF's 'nonviolence' policy.

Against this, we say GA is not so constrained and add that ALF it -self should get real about non/ violence if it's going to tackle a society in which animal exploitation is but one facet of heirarch-


ical Statist power. Violence is just "the illegitimate exercise of power" in my book


and, of course, the powers-that-be determine what's legitimate. Power - that's just what it takes to make someone do what they don't want. That's what all liberation movements are about - forcing the exploiters to stop their bullshit. Any use of power in the interests of social transformation is 'violence' in the State's eyes, whether some exploiter gets smacked in the mouth, gets his windows put through - or not.

Time those calling themselves revolutionaries - and we assume the Band of Mercy do, despite the bullshit liberal language of the 'discussion paper' - stopped talking State language. That language is just another con, another stick it beats us with like all the rest of 'em listed above. State power is no more legitimate than y/ours - it's just another gang, one we aim to bust. We're not going to do that playing chorus to it, echoing its cries of "violence" everytime someone tans its arse. Why not criticise State 'violence' for once, challenging public acquiescence in its definitions, or fuck it off all together as it's our own actions that count?

The non/violence dichotomy is largely false, a bunch of crap that bores us shitless and which armchair revolutionaries toss around between each other instead of discussing - and practicing - what's most effective and the best security arrangements to deal with the State's proportionate and inevitable backlash.



Almost all of the preceding scams rely on complaining and appealing to the scumbag companies desire to maintain good customer relations, so it's also worth remembering that by writing a letter or two occasionally to these companies saying how pleased you are with their products will often result in an occasional supply of free samples, new ranges and vouchers.

WH Smiths is just one high street capitalist operation that is changing its rules on refunds and damaged goods. You can now gointo any branch of WH Smiths in the country with goods sold in any RECIEPT - and claim a voucher and, in some cases, a cash refund. You no longer need proof of purchase. Thank the complaining shoppers of Britain for this, comrades, because the constant stream of rude letters to WHS in .Swindon (the company HQ) from disaffected customers who couldn't

get their money back for damaged or unwanted items has led to a major rethink. A rethink that plays into our hands as anarchists.

HOW TO STUFF SMITHS:

1. Nick a reasonably valuable item, using the usual precautions and diversionary tactics we know so well!!

2. As a cover, buy a cheap item like a pencil or rubber and make sure that the sales assistant gives you a carrier bag. Keep the item for a couple of days or more.

3. Travel to another nearby WH Smiths branch. Saunter up to the assistant with a smile on your face and say "I'm sorry to bother

PERSONS KNOWN AND UNKNOWN

How to be ready to disappear before you need to...

WHAT FOLLOWS IS a description of how to get hold of alternative ID. It is based on what I did seven years ago.

Visit one of the big cemetaries in a large metropolitan area. Read the headstones of deaths around the time you were born. Cemetaries are usually filled up section by section so you won't have to read every one from 1848 to 1993. Try to find the graves of people who died in infancy (though old enough - more than six weeks - to have been issued a birth certificate). Note their date of death, names and ages at death if given.

Armed with this, take a visit to St Catherines House in central London. This is a public building, a bit like a library, so treat it as such. It is here that they keep a complete register of births, deaths and marriages for England, Scotland and Wales.

You can consult all documentation in the building (what a free country we live in!). Back track from dates of death of your chosen people (if you know what ages they were when they croaked, so much easier will this be). When you have found the entries, you somply fill out applecation forms for a copy of their birth certificates. The form asks you if you want a 'short' or 'full' certificate - I got the full one, the difference is it has a little more

info such as space for name of father if any and not a lot more. Cost when I got mine was £6 and £10 respectively for short or full. Also you have to put who you, the applicant, is. I just made up a name and signed it. You are also asked whether you want it posted or to come back three days later to pick it up in person. Don't matter much which you do, except to have an address that is 'safe' if you choose that option.

So far you have broken no laws. Local historians and family tree freaks order up certificates all day long and it's a good government money spinner. So no need to get worked up over it. Armed with a copy of your cert

-ificate, you now ... sit on it. Dirty it up a bit and leave it for six months or so. After a suitable delay, choose a busy social security office such as Kilburn, for example, where there are a lot of Irish, a place where they are used to people applying for allocation of an NI (Irish people are entitled to NI for both Britain and Eire [1]). You then go in and ask for an application form for a National Insurance number. You will probably not get dealt with there and then but have your name and address taken and be given an appointment to return with your birth certificate. At the interview you will tell them you have lost it

or never had one (because you never lived in brick, born and bought up as a traveller, or are Irish: you will have to play the part to go with whatever explanation you give). NI is usually given out just before you leave school, so if you never went to school you maybe can't read and write much or that fast - geddit? As far as I can remember, you will have to pay some more money with your application, sign it and give an address for the card to be sent to - you do not get it there agnd then, nor in person. So again make it safe - it could be construed that you are now trying to obtain ID with intent to defraud. 6-8 weeks later, you'll get the card through the post, and away you go. Get a job (!), sign on, whatever [2].

If you wanna rip off a bank, apply for an account. You new need a passport [3] or birth certificate. You get fuck all to start with - a cheque book with no guarantee card and a cash point card to take out only what you have put in. So you've got to wait again; move some money in, take it out, back and forwards for six/nine months, until you look like a regular drone. Them apply for a cheque card and away you go

The ability to become someone else in a hurry is a process you

have to sort out now, before it becomes necessary. Because when the time comes to disappear it will be too late to go through this

FOOTNOTES

1. The Irish angle might be a good one - the IRA, bless 'em, blew up all the Northern Ireland records a decade or so ago.

2. The only way they can prove that you are not the person you have 'adopted' is to prove you are who you actually are. There was, at the time I done this, and I believe still the case, that there is no cross reference between births and deaths in any govirnment department in this country. You'll only get caught out if you get stopped with two sets of ID or get visited at any address you give and have your legal ID there.

3. One year passports can be got with a letter to your address, a birth certificate and a bus pass. For ten year passports you need to send away yourbirth certificate and have photoes countersigned by a doctor, copper, teacher, some upstanding geek of the community. Probably to be avoided. Also to avoid is the medical profession as a whole, as your death is on a file somewhere along with your birth.

An insensitive and street-fighting attitude can only alienate anti-fascist groups from natural areas of support and from potential allies, however annoying and uncomfortable we may feel at times towards them.

That said, the last issue was great - the cover drawn by Graham Burnett was probably one of the best I've seen!

BOOKS

NO MASTER HIGH OR LOW BY JOHN SHOTTON. LIB ED.

"No master high or low" - the title of a poem by the 19th-century anarchist/socialist William Morris.

This piece of intelligent research effectively rubbishes academia's version of schooling history. A clear distinction between Libertarian (anarchist), and 'Progressive' schooling, the latter under which the two are normally lumped together, is drawn.

The bourgeious tendancy of Progressive educators such as Montessori is exposed. The conspiracy to deliberately omit working class traditions of Libertarian education from current textbooks on schooling history by publishers is a point not lost on the author either.

One staggeringly funny thing I learned from reading this book was how the International School 1890, the first anarchist school in UK and the inspiration for the development of libertarian schools in this country, "was opened on the advice of a M. Coulon, an agent provocateur who had hit on the idea of a school as a relative -ly easy was to keep political exiles [anarchists fleeing the destruction of the Paris Commune] under survaillence ... the school was closed by the authorities ... police apparently discovered bombs and bomb-making equipment in the basement of the school."

Every claim is backed up with evidence - all the usual things you would expect from a scholarly study of history. The academic style of the book is brightened by excursions into personal testimonies - the latest fashion craze for presenting history in bite-sized form. An air of innocence in children's own accounts delivers a knock-out sideswipe at the media and their use of 'sound bites' to obfuscate the libertarian ideals behind 1970s free schools.

If you are a sociology student or studying for a career in teaching, this book provides all the hard evidence for condemning your standard Left- or Right-biased text-books of schooling history to the pulp fiction rack.


Not just a study book - an affirming read for anarchists and for parents exploring the alternatives to sentencing their children to a State school 'education'.

'TRAVELLERS - VOICES OF THE NEW AGE' BY RICHARD LOWE 6 WILLIAM SHAW. FOURTH ESTATE, £8.99.

A brilliant sociological study of travellers consisting of 30 interviews with them. They talk about their lives, experiences, outlook, problems with authority. One of the six sections is about the Beanfield and what came after. There is a graphic description of Yellow Wednesday at Twyford. Many of the piople speaking were also at Stoney Cross or Nostell Priory. It covers the mystical side and crossover from the rave scene. What makes people become

of people who don't give am shit about society, about washing machines, about three piece suites, mortgages and flash cars".


It doesn't show travellers as saints, but it's not out to demonize them. This is a book to buy, read and pass on to folks hostile to travellers. It will open their eyes....



DEEP ECOLOGY AND ANARCHISM
- A POLEMIC. FREEDOM PRESS,
80pps, £2.50.

This is a serious and wordy book, which grew out of Raven 17 - 'On Land'. Deep Ecology is a look at green philosophy in debate form. Rodney Aitchey reviews the course of ecological thought from Rachel Carson to Arne Naess. Graham Purchase writes (critically) about Murray Bookchin, while Brian Morris is better on George Bradford and the Foreman/ Bookchin debaste, but is more hostile towards Naess. Bookchin then responds to the others, mostly attacking Purchase. This part is Polemic with a capital 'P'. The book is topped and tailed by Robert Hart,s Can Life Survive? and Chris Wilbert's well researched history of the apple.

Deep Ecology And Anarchism won't please everybody, but all you serious thinkers and Bookchin bookworms out there should get it and give it a good look over.



THE QUEEN AND I BY SUE TOWNSEND. METHUEN, £9.99.

Well known for the Adrian Mole diary, Sue Townsend has written another book which is high in the bestseller lists. The Queen And I represents all that is wrong with present day political satire. It lacks the couracge to condemn, instead it settles for gentle, inoffensive mockery.

This book is billed as "provocative" - "brilliantly subversive fiction for the nineties". It is neither.

The cental premiss of the book - that the royals are rehoused in a midlands council estate, is stripped of any subversive content it might perhaps have had by the fact that we know from page 14 onwards that the story is only the Queen's election night nightmare. The supposed overturning is not for real, the social order of things is never really questioned. In Hell Close, the queen is still the queen, despite all their setbacks the other royals retain their positions of superiority. Even Charlie is still Charlie, despite being fitted up and imprisoned for attacking a copper. The royals' working class neighbours are stereotypes, patronizingly portrayed as criminals and oiks. The residents of Hell Close are ever ready with their cups of tea, stolen melamine and Dunkirk spirit to help the royals through each crisis. Instead of real concern for the ravaged Flowers estate, we have cliche.

This book ostensibly seeks to draw the ends of the social divide together, and it uses that divide as a vehicle for comedy. What would happen if royalty were to really see how the other 99% lives? It asks, but in leaving things intact it ultimately fails to condemn the Tory ravaged wasteland. It mocks the collapse of society, but does not curse. It does not blame those responsible, it goes to the edge, but does not plunge over it. This is why it fails.

Wally Hope was active on the scene, especially the Stonehenge event, and this involvement led him into conflict with the powers that be threatened by such events. So they had him in 1975, put him in a psychiatric hospital where he was eventually destroyed and turned into a shell, resulting in his suicide. A timely reminder of what the



The only thing that remains obscure now is which monarch? Does Green Monarchist support Queen Elizabeth or King Richard?

FILM

'MALCOLM X' BY SPIKE LEE.

We had to wait six months for this. Was it worth waiting? YES but we have some reservations about the Malcolm X industry and the spectacularisation of X as a cult figure.

Most of the first half of the film is spent building up to the moment where small time hustler, 'Detroit Red' becomes 'Malcolm X' a convert to the Nation of Islam and a believer in the "Prophet" Elijah Mohammed.

which tracks down from a bill-board into the streets, the period atmosphere of the 1940's is evocat -ively recreated. The first part is bouyantly supported by the backing tracks - Billie Holiday, Dinah Washington, Duke Ellington. This is set against Malcolm's denial of his Black identity - putting chemicals on his hair to straighten it - "Make it white" - all the way through to his rejection of his Black girlfriend in favour of Laura, a white woman

Three sequences in the first part of the film are really effective; Roseland Ballroom, the Joe Louis railroad dining car, and the Russian roulette bit where Malcolm palms the bullet.

All this leads up to his imprison -ment, and then to his conversion. Malcolm is shown the white man's

dictionary, and asked to compare the definition of 'black' and 'white'. He is told "The truth's in there, but you gotta read between the lines".

Sadly, the second half of the film doesn't live up to the excellence of the first. The main reason for this is that instead of concentrating on Malcolm X as a political activist, it attempts to turn him into a politically correct religious leader. Much of the second half concentrates on his pilgrimage to Mecca, and so side steps the context of the racialist American state in which Malcolm X flourished. Another aspect of this problem in the second half is the narrative confusion between X's growing conflict with Elijah Mohammed, and the FBI who are bugging him/ following him. The structural interference between the two plot lines becomes so great that in the end (and this is probably intentional) we are left confused as to who exactly pulled the trigger.

This PC-ness eventually collapses in its own incoherence at the very end, when Mandela/Mohammed is seen as a school teacher giving a sermon about

The second half has its moments though. The earlier sequence of flashing white faces where Malcolm comes to believe that all white people are evil is resolved in his reconciliation to all races during his Mecca pilgrimage. One important step in this rejection of racism happens on the university steps. when a patronising, but well meaning white student asks what she should do to help liberate Black people, to which Malcolm

Two other sequences in the second half which are good are the interview after the assassination of Kennedy, which he calls "Chickens coming home to roost" and the TV studio sequence about the field negro and the house

Lastly, the magisterial build-up of tension in the Brother Johnson sequence where the Nation of Islam surround a police station after one of their speakers is beaten up and arrested has to be mentioned. The moment where Mal-colm X confronts the police is almost certainly the best moment of the film. Even then, his humanity shines through in the triumphant smirk he flashes at the police chief before ordering his followers to disperse.

All in all then, this film perhaps would have been better if it had been shorter and hadn't pulled its punches over his politics. Even so, it's well worth seeing....

MIGHTY MIGHTY BOSSTONES DON'T KNOW HOW TO PARTY.

For all of us lucky enough to hear the Bosstones first two LPs, this is a bit of a disappiontment. The guitars are too high and metally, the brass section too quiet and more like the James Taylor Quartette or Fishbone than their usual groovy Ska sound which could put the old Blaggers set up, before the old sax player got arrested at the Cocksparrow gig and went home to Germany and got a job. On the plus side, this record does have its ups, like the storming Someday I Suppose off their recent 12" which lifts this LP above the average. A band well worth checking out live, for sure.

SEXLESS PISTOLS - DENY. £7 FROM MANDALA, PO BOX 344, LONDON SE19 1EQ.

As you can guess from the name of the band, they sound like the Sex Pistols but what makes this lots different from all the others is their good anarcho lyrics by Steerpike. I've heard people pay £25 for this thinking it's a lost Sex Pistols LP, so if you like them check this out.

AOS/3 - GODS SECRET AGENT LP. £5 FROM AOS/3 c/o SCOERC, 44 MOWBRAY ROAD, HENDON, SUNDERLAND

A classic first bit of vinyl from this lively, bouncey punk/ska band, muchly taken from their 'apparent -ly we had a great time' studio and live tape, all this time lovingly recreated in the studio. This LP is living proof that situationism is alive and well and living in Sunderland. Well worth a listen.

BACK TO THE PLANET - DAY-DREAMING EP.

A more poppy EP from BTTP, but that goes with the territory we guess. We still like their personal brand of dancable ska but Phil does sound like Kate Bush. The two unreleased tracks are really cool as, if you've ever seen BTTP in the last 21 years, you must know Daydreaming, with Talkin' Time being a powerful, more disco tune blast at modern life and with Breathin' Roots a full-on ska stormer, Hammond-sounding organ and all.

To add our tuppence to the sell out debate, BTTP were never a revolutionary band and by signing to a major label have sold noe of their own values out, just those of some of their fans who wrongly stuck their own views onto the band and who felt betrayed when the band moved on.

BTTP have a debut LP out in September for those of us still interested.

WHO MOVED THE GROUND? -BARNEY DANCING EP. £2.60 FROM C SHEPHERD, 37 BROAD-LANDS COURT, WORKINGHAM ROAD, BRACKNELL RG12 1PJ.

Bustling poppy punk not too unlike the House Martins with one song sung as if by Elvis Costello. This is the first single from this hard-working band and it hasn't let them down. On to greater things? Who knows?

AIR-RIFLES INTO DIESEL FIRE-

With very little effort and almost no cost you can double the power of your air-rifle without adding washers behind the cocking spring. If you go to the trouble of using washers to increase spring pressure, then additional diesel power will give you the weapon motherfucking edge if you fancy yourself as an assassin.

Diesel engines work by rapidly compressing air in the cylinder. if air is compressed fast enough it will reach temperatures exceeding 600 degrees C - well hot enough to ignite diesel oil when it is injected into the cylinder. Simply apply this principle to your airrifle; you can even be green about it, using bio-diesel fuel (vegetable cooking oil) instead of mineral diesel oil. I have experimented and found that the best results were achieved by using cotton wool dipped in chip oil plugged into the back of ordinary lead pellets. Don't use too much cotton wool just enough to half fill the pellet

Fire a few normal pellets into a block of wood, then try an oiled pellet. It srhould penetrate the block to twice the depth of ordinary pellets. Now blow down the barrel and if light blue smoke puffs out, you used the optimum amount of oil to suit the spring air pressure. Dark smoke means either too much oil or not enough spring pressure.

CURSE OF THE ELFIN

"It's been found to the cost of the technocrats that computer systems can be 'crashed' by exposing them to microwave radiation just like that found in normal microwave ovens! This accidental discovery means it's simple for any member of the public to cause malicious computers to crash from a safe distance! No break-in, no hacking required.

Sadly the units that make the microwaves in ovens spread the beams out to cover a wide area so they are dangerous to the operator and have a very short range. SAT-ELLITE TV to the rescue. The dish aerials are perfectly designed to focus an incoming beam of energy to a point - they also work in reverse to creatie a narrow str-

So the idea was born to replace the TV reciever unit with a micro -wave transmitter of low power. Low power is all that's needed to crash a computer or jam a walkietalkie and it has the advantage of a smaller power supply. One watt is low power.


If you want to experiment with full power 650 watt oven power then you'd better be damn careful not to get burned.

These powers can cook! Mounting the microwave unit on the satelloite dish needs great care to put it at exactly the rocus point for that dish. (Consult experienced engineering folk).

Make sure the microwave beams are directed towards the centre of the dish, so they don't spill over around the edges. It's best to avoid exposure to even low powers of microwave energy (fix guard).

Dishes have various mounting brackets on them to provide handles for the operator, ot is useful to fix sights if you want a chance of hitting the target quickly, although slow sweeps can be used to take out a whole area.

A trigger-like switch is highly recommended so there is a fail-

safe (ie. if you let go of the switch, then the power cuts off). Also it seems to be the onset of the beams does the most damage, so pulsing the trigger will be more effective than leaving it held

Perhaps someone out there will invent a pulsing buzzer switch which might increase effectiveness, but so far it's a silent unit ideal for concealed use.

This unit crashes computers by screwing up the data in its memory. It doesn't damage the computer physically at all, so they can just switch it off for a while and use it again later. The most effect -ive times to use it are when information such as accounts is being printed out or when data is being typed in.

Information on discs is not affected by the microwaves, but a strong magnet 'wiped' across hthe top of boxes of discs will invisibly delete the information on them permenantly.

RANGE AND ACCURACY

This depends mainly on how narrow the beam of M-waves is. A badly set up dish will disperse the energy so it diverges quickly but a properly aligned system makes a beam like a laser that may carry energy for quarter to half a mile.

Try removing the glass from a van window, replacing it with card -board. Then slowly drive past the target building with a passenger activating the beamer as needed.

Invisible hit, easy getaway! Can be confirmed with binoculars if you can watch the computer operators suddenly start to panic.

POWER SUPPLY

Well, you can use mains electricity if you keep the original microwave oven electronics. Disadvantages are Too High Power Output and long mains cables. Not portable.

If 12 volt ovens are available from your local caravan shop then it's easy to provide a car battery to power the thing.

THIS IS GREEN ANARCHISM

CIVILIZATION IS EXPLOITATION

Mass society is too complex to work without specialisation. Specialised division of labour alienates us from each other and creates a heirarchy needed to co-ordinate production. Heirarchy divides society into the powerful and powerless. The powerless are treated as objects to be exploited. Exploitation on grounds of class, gender, ethnicity and sexual prefer -ence is intrinsic to mass society. Mass society cannot be reformed. It must be replaced.

SMALL IS BEAUTIFUL

Mass society must be replaced with communities small enough for

each person in them to be respect -ed as an autonomous individual. In small communities, self-determination would replace heirarchy. You can't fight mass with mass. If our means and ends are to be consistent, we must organise in networks of autonomous small groups to replace mass society.

LAND OR DEATH

Mass society alienates people from the Earth. By controlling the Earth's resources, the State controls society. We must end our dependance on the State by taking back the land and living selfsufficiently. By re-establishing our relationship with the Earth, we

undermine the heirarchical thinking that is destroying it.

REVOLUTION ON THE PERIPHERY

Mass society needs resources from across the planet to survive. Those most exploited by it are those that work the land in the Third World, only to have the fruits of their labour exported to profit the rich. They have nothing to lose by taking back the land at the expense of mass society. As less resources are imported from the Third World, mass society won't be able to come up with the goods in this country. Self-governing, self-sufficient small communities will be more needed and easier to

establish as the State loses control of the rest of the planet. AUTONOMY NOW

We must support the revolution on the periphery by making our own here. We must share the skills needed to survive without the State, create a culture of resistance to free us from the alienation of mass society, live free of exploitation by boycotting banks and multinationals, building an alternative green and black economy and defending ourselves and the Earth by taking direct action against military bases and labs, developers and industry, exploitation and intolerance.


