CLAREMONT CLEARANCES

AT £2 MILLION, Claremont Road evict -ion was most expensive in UK. It took 41 days and 1,000+ cops, sheriffs officers, bailiffs and contractors.

Claremont Road was the last strong -hold of No M11 Link, Leytonstone's autonomous zone. By mid-November, Dolly, the street's last legit resident was moved out and the DoT had warrants against all its houses. Squatters had the whole summer to instal tank traps and barricades, bunkers and lock-ons, armoured tree houses and scramble nets, towers and even a 400' tunnel to neighbouring streets 28th NOVEMBER

Half Claremont Road's 3-400 defenders were swept from the street in minutes as the Met set their cordon - the west end fell fast too but attempts to clear the east end went bad as a cherry picker hit a power line. One street-level lock-on with his arm through a 6'x4' 3/4" steel plate held out until way after dark!

A woman also fell 20' from the west net to the street as it was cleared. Cops were busy with pushes on their outer cordon, elves diverting traffic into it and people infiltrating his house and four in a rooftop triplesupplies across the Central line.



We are publishing the Lesbian & Gay Freedom Movement's provocative pro-porn piece to stimulate debate. We're doing this as we think the orthodox Dworkin-McKinnon position on porn is shite and repressive

THE LESBIAN AND GAY Freedom Movement is campaigning for a world without male power, sexism and sexual violence, but unlike many groups who advocate the banning of pornography, LGFM totally oppose the elimination of pornography as a way forward. We believe that no pornography is sexist and some can be liberating. It has in no way been established that there is a link between pornography and sexual violence.

It is so easy to blame pornography for what's wrong with this society, because that is exactly what the State wants - more laws to censor and oppress us. We are living in right-wing anti-sex times, with the Government attacking anyone whose sex or sexuality challenges the nuclear family (eg. section 28, attacks on abortion rights and artificial insemination, Operation Spanner). They would certainly support a move against pornography so whose side are these groups such as Campaign Against Pornography, Cambridge Anarchists and so on, exactly on?

Pornography is a complete distraction from the real causes of sexism and sexual violence. Sexism is mirrored in images, and not created by images. We want people to talk about and challenge institutionalised male power and sexism in the real world; not attack our fantasies which are completely different from what we do in our everyday lives. We want people, and especially men, to challenge sexism and male power in the workplace, the pub, in the nuclear family, in schools, and in advertising, TV, magazines, which constantly show women in the role of servicing men, rather than as people.

We believe that a more radical approach is needed to challenge male power and sexism and sexual violence in our society. 

The limits of our imagination hold us back more than State surveillance technologies


WE LIVE IN A POLICE STATE where meaningful opposition has been margin -alised. Now with the CJA dissent is being made illegal. If you want to take meaningful action against it you will find it harder. It will be necessary to work outside the law. Because we are all criminals now, our ability to act and continue acting depend on invisibility. The State has never been constrained by questions of legality nor should we. It will use all means necessary to eliminate activists. Again and again experience shows if the State gets hold of an activist they'll be fitted up. It will plant evidence, fabricate 'confessions' just to put them out of the way. Failing all this it will murder them.

Try to understand the mindset of the enemy. A secret policeman/woman is a sadistic authoritarian - a power worshipping bully. Because the organization thinks for them they can't believe in freedom, they assume every organisation is made in the same pattern. The revolutionary world must be a shadow of their own authoritarian, heirarchic organization. That's one reason why smears against the ALF, hunt sabs, Class War all assume these movements have leaders. Activists must be under the thumb, only acting on orders. The idea of autonomy scares them shitless.

COMPUTERS

The central weapon the State uses against people is information stored in computers. There are now two Police National Computers (PNC) and any police station has a terminal to tap into this. PNC is connected to electoral rolls and the DVLC at Swansea. 

Police and Group 4 use still and video cameras at demonstrations. The main cause for concern here are traffic cameras installed overlooking main roads and motorways. At the time of the '84 Miner's Strike, CRS Systems Lodge, Texas Street, Morley, Leeds, developed a camera to read car number plates [see GA32, p.6]. Connected up to PNC, this will be a powerful tool for tracking activists' cars through the traffic system. Private detectives and State security agencies also use 'Bumper Beepers' - tiny transmitters attached to the underside of cars [3]. These are manufactured by Micromill Electro -nics, Unit 5, Old Flour Mill, Queen Street, Ensworth, Hampshire PO10 7BT (tel: 0243 378160).



in a conspiracy to rob. What gesture, what movement, what contact with another person cannot be represented as criminal by those who watch the screens in secret? Those who are picked out, arrested, charged and convicted, must join the ranks of criminals and become stigmatised and dangerous. Criminality and danger and the places where they occur are all products of the State, and it seems reasonablpe to be afraid of what the State has produced in order to frighten us. It can also seem reasonable to expect the State to do something to curb the danger it has produced.

So when Green Anarchist editors speak of people as "passive scum" who rely on the State to protect them, they are failing to look at the reasons why people feel threatened by something which is not of their own making and not in their control, and why they look for help to the only organisation which appears capable of If we accipt criminality as a necess

Science is not a myth but a method of seeking knowledge of nature. If you "can't get away from it" thats because you cant get away from nature except in fantasy. The Juice Bandits article (GA35) was a good example of using science for liberatory purposes but it also showed the need for sufficient technical knowledge to avoid electrocuting yourself, setting fire to your home or being thrown in the slammer. There is nothing liberatory about any of these.

The Survival article on Weed-Killers (GA36) is an illustration of learning the hard way that dogmatic antiscience and technology attitudes are not very useful when it comes to practical problems of growing food. Chemical technology can be essential in this area provided we have the scientifc knowledge of how to use it effectively and safely.

Like closing the bow doors after the flagship rolled over, it's business as usual as though it never happened that's enought to make any selfrespectin' rioter throw a mollie. There's nothing fundamentally wrong with the design of the ship. You can tell the sort of book this is because they uncritically accept Borough Treasurer's returns on the levels of non-payment and even pay tributes to their "professionalism and dedication" (pp. 265, 277) PHUAARGH! We say they should be tried before peoples' courts and then executed by slow and painful methods for crimes against humanity.

The main lie this book tells is the poll tax fell for bureaucratic and electoral reasons. It playts down non-payment and violence. On p. 259, for example, they can't even get the name of the Militant-dominated "All Britain Anti-Poll Tax Federation" right (though they managed this on p.151). The officially admitted figure of 11 million prosecutions isn't even mentioned, instead it becomes "hundreds of thousands of prosecutions" (p. 289). The brilliant March 1990 wave of regional town hall protests and riots are barely mentioned. Trafalgar Square is discussed for three pages (pp. 151-153), less than 1% of the book. In language ominously shadowing police press releases at the time, the riot is blamed on "a hardcore of agnitprop activists intent on mayhem" (p. 152).


The rage of the placard-waving "agotprop activist" on the cover, cynically used to sell the book, is not carried through inside. There's no anger against hthe government here, no rage against the humiliation of poor people being dragged through the magistrates courts. "Inability to pay is no defence". No detailed accounts are given about the court processes. This was a disgraceful part of the history of the poll tax, the nadmir of British so-called 'justice', but it is hardly even mentioned. "Full agnd gripping" story eh? There is no mention of the physical war against poll tax bailiffs on the estates. Nothing much is said about the jailings - Terry Fields is mentioned (p. 262), what about the rest? We have nothing about the secret agenda of the tax - the vicious pull to the centre of that political black holpe called Conservatism; the disenfranchisement of the poor; the introduction of ID cards. The whole thing was just an unfortunate administrative error. The MPs, backwoods peers and Borough Treaurers are all safe here - they were only obeying orders so that makes it all right. The authors (two academics and an FT journo) are more bothered to plaster over the chasm than to tell the real story about the earthquake. Fundamentally it's a revisionist account. Can the credibility of Local Government be restored? Can the Challenger





PEOPLE started when Coventry lawyer read an article by population bomber Paul Ehrlich in Playboy and the party that formed around him combined 1970's community politics and survivalism (member John Abineri was, at that time, star of BBC1 'after doomsday' serial, The Survivors!). They won the backing of Edward Goldsmith, grand old man of UK Green politics, farcical campaign ensued, including "long-haired [disguised] as Arabs" and a camel borrowed from Rightist zoo owner, John Aspinall!

He retaliated in his Neoist newsletter, Re:Action, by claiming "if we understand fascism as a vampire that feeds on real social movements, then not only is Hunt's Alternative Green fascist, so are the closet cases who adhere to a more genteel version of the same doctrine within the Green Anarchist Network". Home's "arbitary invention" (ie lying) and sectarianism-for-it's-own-sake better fits his definition of "fascism" and, to informed readers, his laughable accusation is just another example of it at work.

So, to treat Home to a taste of his own medicene, GA now exclusively reveals Home's association with Screwdriver goes way beyond acknowledgements on record sleeves a decade ago. No, we've been reliably informed by Gerry Gable that not only was Home the booby prize in Blood & Honour's One Shag Of The Year competition but that the late Ian Stewart himself was paid to goosestep up and down Home's naked back wearing nothing but a pickelhauber and jackboots whilst pretending this sad man was Poland!

Seriously, Home still tries to worm his way into the Independent's good books. When GA dragged their Jason Bennetto before the Press Complaints Commission for repeating John Harlow/ARNI's "Green guerrilla" lies [see GA36] in the wake of Claremont Road's eviction - GA were named in the story and refused right of reply - Home started saying he'd know Harlow for 17 years and found him reliable. What interest could Home have in the Sunday Times' Transport correspondent? He isn't even old enough for Home to have known Harlot professionally that long!

THE NEXTISSUE
